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## OVERVIEW

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Built for confident cruising, the 62 from ILIAD Catamarans is a motor yacht catamaran featuring a fiberglass and plastic hull and fiberglass decks. Listed by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, this 62-foot design pairs a broad beam with efficient twin-diesel propulsion to deliver seaworthy passagemaking and comfortable liveaboard accommodations.

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Q1: What type of yacht is the 62? A1: It's a motor yacht catamaran built on a fiberglass and plastic hull, engineered for comfortable, efficient cruising.

Q2: What are the performance figures? A2: The 62 achieves a **cruising speed** of 18 kn (20.71 mph) and a **top speed** of 21 kn (24.17 mph).

## Owner Experience Review

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Owners and reviewers commonly describe the 62 from ILIAD Catamarans as a true long-range bluewater platform, with expert assessments quoting ranges in excess of >3,300–3,500 nm when operated at displacement speeds. Many owners use it as a full-time liveaboard for months, and the model is also popular for owner-operator cruising and charter—there are operational examples in Australia. During trials sailors noted the motion: "The ride is tranquil and very smooth," and measured consumption supports that pattern—roughly ~2.0 L/nm at 8 kn for passage-making versus about ~11.0 L/nm at ~21 kn when driven hard.

Handling in close quarters is praised as straightforward: helms provide excellent sightlines, Seastar electric steering feels responsive, and twin engines give precise maneuver control so bow or stern thrusters are rarely needed. For remote cruising, robust grounding skegs permit controlled beaching for inspection or emergency maintenance when shore facilities are unavailable.

Aboard, the sense is one of abundant space—owners remark you can almost forget you're on a yacht, given the volume. Living is spread across three

distinct levels: a capacious flybridge seating approximately ten, roomy aft cockpit and foredeck lounging, and interior dining space for 8–12 guests. The galley and storage are configured for prolonged voyaging with very large refrigeration and freezer capacity, a dishwasher and BLUM hardware, and the owner's hull can be tailored to include laundry, workshop, office, or crew quarters. Engine rooms are designed for accessibility, and owners commend after-sales attention ("They really take care of their customers") and mechanical confidence ("Engineering-wise, we cannot fault our ILIAD.").

## Pros and Cons

- Very efficient at passage speeds (~2.0 L/nm at 8 kn) with expert-cited range >3,300–3,500 nm for bluewater cruising and liveaboard use.
- Expansive three-level layout with a large flybridge (~10 people), big cockpit and bow lounging, and dining for 8–12.
- Owner-friendly operation and upkeep with excellent helm visibility, responsive Seastar electric steering, optimized engine-room access, and strong after-sales support.
- Efficiency and range are optimized at displacement speeds, so running fast trades fuel economy for time.
- At full throttle the burn rises to around 11.0 L/nm at ~21 kn, cutting practical range versus passage numbers of ~2.0 L/nm at 8 kn.
- Beaching on grounding skegs is intended for emergency inspection/repairs rather than routine practice.
