Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers are drawn to the 245 Center Console by INTREPID POWERBOATS INC because it performs exactly as intended: supporting divers, anglers, and recreational boaters, while also functioning as an upscale family dayboat or a premium tender. On the water, its single-step, deep-V hull is engineered for pace and maintains composure, slicing through seas with effective wave penetration and responsive handling credited to vacuum-bagged, robust construction. Owners often express pride in owning these boats, particularly when used as tenders or for high-performance day missions.

Inside, the full console—featuring a head compartment with 6 feet, 2 inches of headroom—stands out for a boat of this size. The layout’s flexibility comes from forward seating, an integrated fiberglass folding aft bench, plentiful lockable storage, and optional electrically actuated chaise lounge V-seats, allowing significant owner customization. The 150-gallon fuel tank and an open, well-organized deck support longer-day runs and comfortable family outings.

Maintenance is generally straightforward and focused on the outboard powerplant; owners commonly run Mercury Verado or Yamaha engines and stress routine service plus prop and lower-unit care. Listings frequently cite engine hours (for example, a 300-hp Mercury Verado with about 475 hours) as part of the condition report. Importantly, there is little public evidence of systemic structural or systems failures in shared forums; most available insight comes from professional test reports and sales listings, which buyers should

supplement with targeted pre-purchase inspections.

Pros and Cons

- Deep-V, single-step hull provides a composed and confident ride at speed.
- Flexible layout with forward seating, a folding aft bench, and generous storage fits diving, fishing, and family outings.
- Full console with 6'2" headroom and a 150-gallon fuel capacity increase comfort and range for day trips.
- Designed primarily for daytime operations and tender duties rather than extended liveboard cruising.
- Ongoing ownership responsibilities include regular outboard service and prop/drive maintenance.
- Long-term owner-failure data in public forums is limited, so research is often based on expert reviews and current listings.

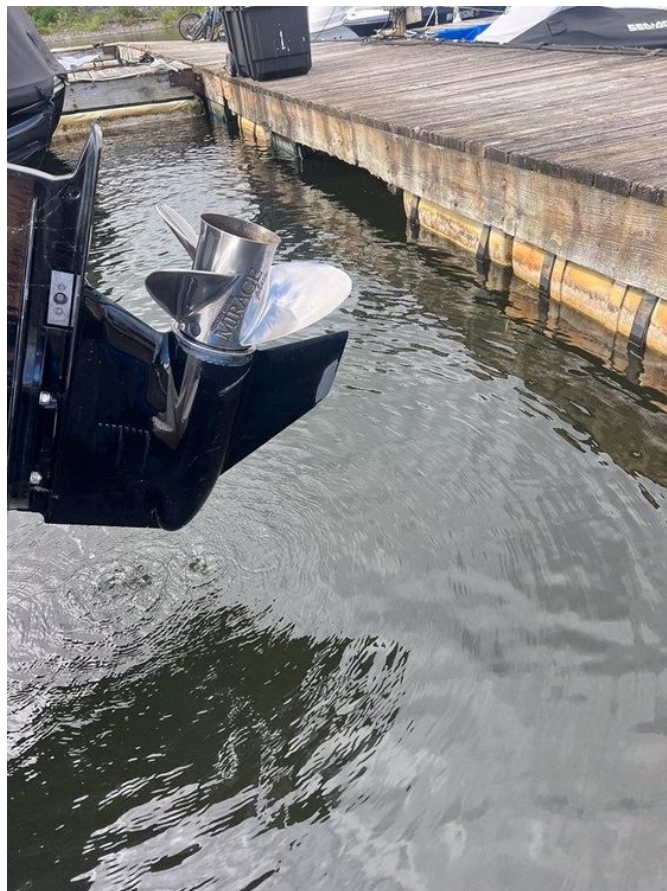

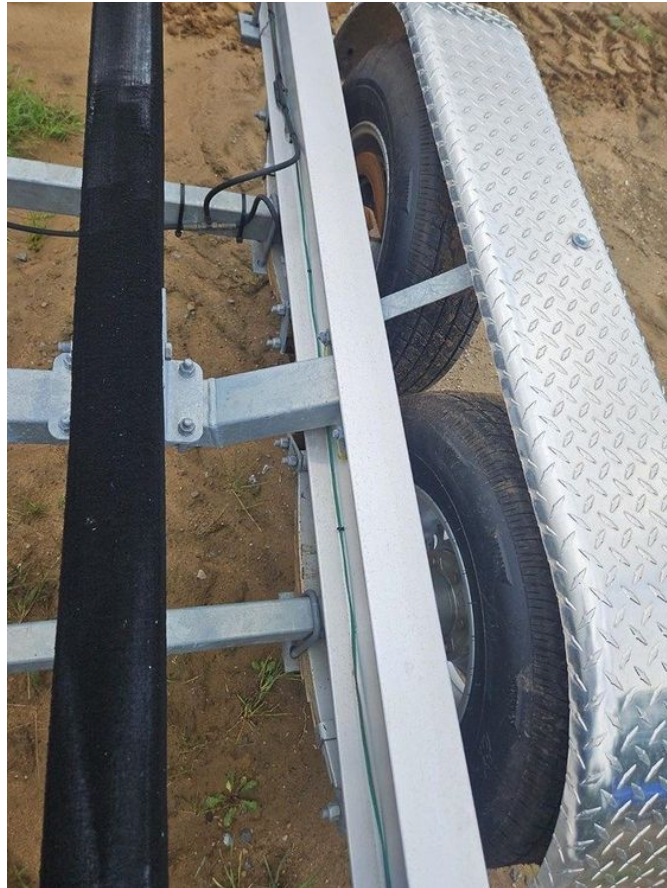
