OVERVIEW

Crafted for owners who prize straightforward performance and uncomplicated systems, the 366 Cuddy from INTREPID POWERBOATS INC offers a practical blend of dayboat agility and modest cruising ability. Built on a fiberglass hull, it pairs twin Yamaha outboard power with a cozy cuddy designed for two, and a sensible balance of fuel and freshwater stores. Presented for sale by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov handling inquiries.

Selecting a 366 Cuddy

When evaluating the right boat for your needs, consider how you plan to run and where you intend to cruise. The 366 Cuddy combines a compact profile with an overnight cuddy for two and a single head, all driven by twin Yamaha outboards for uncomplicated operation. As a motor yacht constructed on a fiberglass foundation, it appeals to owners seeking durable, low maintenance construction paired with reliable outboard propulsion.

Features of the Model

- Twin Yamaha outboards (gas) that simplify maintenance while delivering assured handling.
- Cuddy configuration providing berths for two and one head, enabling weekend getaways.
- Robust fiberglass construction complemented by a fiberglass deck for longevity.
- Functional onboard capacities: 300 gal fuel and 30 gal water for extended day runs or short cruises.
- Compact overall dimensions that ease docking and make trailering and marina logistics more manageable.

Q: What **engines** power the 366 Cuddy? A: The vessel is fitted with twin Yamaha **outboards** configured to run on **gas** .

Q: How many **berths** and **heads** does it have? A: The layout **sleeps 2** and includes **1 head** , suited to short overnight trips.

Q: What are the key **dimensions** ? A: The boat's **LOA** measures 36 ft (11.12 m), the **beam** is 10 ft (3.2 m), and the maximum **draft** is 6.562 ft (2 m).

Q: What is the **hull** and **deck** made of? A: The hull is constructed of fiberglass,

while the **deck** is Fiberglass.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the 366 Cuddy from INTREPID POWERBOATS INC because it functions equally well as a sporty dayboat or a capable sportfisher, while still accommodating family cruising and short overnight stays. The cuddy cabin typically includes air conditioning, a galley outfitted with a microwave and refrigerator, forward horseshoe seating, and an enclosed head with shower, providing genuine utility for weekend trips. Above decks, a roomy cockpit, wraparound bow seating, rod holders, and bolsters make both entertaining and fishing straightforward.

On the water the design's deep V hull with a stepped bottom and a moderate beam is frequently praised for keeping the ride dry while delivering strong performance. Owners and sellers report confident handling and a stable feel in choppy conditions. Top speed and cruise figures vary with power: factory configurations with triple 225s historically produced a roughly 35 knot cruise and about 50 knots top end, whereas repowered examples have reported cruise speeds around 38 mph and advertised top speeds exceeding 60 mph, depending on outboard selection.

From an ownership perspective, many examples have been repowered—common upgrades include Suzuki DF300/350 or Yamaha F350 units to enhance reliability and economy. Typical refits noted in listings are power assist hydraulic steering, modern Garmin electronics, new radar/autopilot systems, and FLIR thermal cameras. Some owners have upgraded to a 36V battery configuration so the cabin AC can run without

constant generator use. Generators and older electrical installations are often service items; at least one listing specifically mentioned a Kohler generator requiring repair. As a semi custom model with varied refits over time, individual equipment and layout details can differ significantly between boats.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V stepped hull provides a dry ride and confident, stable handling in choppy seas.
- Cuddy cabin equipped with AC, galley amenities, and an enclosed head/shower supports family cruising and short overnight stays.
- Flexible layout and performance accommodate day boating, offshore or nearshore fishing, and extended island runs.
- Repowering is common, so engine age and the quality of any repower are important ownership considerations.
- Generator and electrical systems can require periodic service; at least one listing noted a generator in need of repair.
- Being semi custom, equipment and layouts vary between individual boats, so careful comparison across listings is advised.
