OVERVIEW

Built by INTREPID POWERBOATS INC, the 390 Sport Yacht is a high end motor yacht in the broader motor yachts category, built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull and driven by twin Yamaha outboards. Presented by Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team, it pairs assured handling with a purposeful interior for fast escapes and efficient days on the water.

Selecting a 390 Sport Yacht

Opting for the 390 Sport Yacht signals a preference for straightforward power and uncomplicated ownership. With twin Yamaha outboards (gas/petrol) and a 12 ft (3.66 m) beam, this motor yacht provides a stable platform for both daytime cruising and short overnight trips. The accommodation is focused — a single berth and one head — while a 390 gallon fuel tank gives extra range for longer passages. Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales can assist with build choices and delivery timing through INTREPID POWERBOATS INC.

- Q: What is the yacht's primary **type** ? A: The 390 Sport Yacht is classified as a motor yacht within the wider motor yachts market, constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull.
- Q: What **engines** power this model? A: It is fitted with **twin Yamaha outboards** that run on **gas/petrol** , chosen for simple maintenance and lively performance.
- Q: What are the **accommodations** like? A: The interior layout includes **sleeping for 1** and **1 head** , designed primarily for focused overnight use and

weekend trips.

- Q: What are the onboard **capacities** ? A: The boat carries **390 gallons of fuel** and **60 gallons of water** , enabling longer day runs and flexible itineraries.

Owner Experience Review

Owners select the 390 Sport Yacht from INTREPID POWERBOATS INC for its adaptability across day boating, fishing, and mixed use missions. The cockpit's generous footprint, ample sun and lounge surfaces, and a removable aft bench are ideal for social days, while anglers benefit from dedicated cockpit fishboxes, a livewell, and a raw water washdown. Up front, a broad lounge with electric adjust backrests beneath a hardtop keeps guests relaxed, and many owners have specified an optional hullside dive door for easier water access.

Belowdecks, the arrangement supports family overnights with a forward queen berth and a convertible settee, teak & holly flooring, a compact galley with sink and microwave, and an enclosed head with a separate shower. Common listings include standard air conditioning, a generator, and upgraded electronics, making weekend cruising practical and comfortable rather than aspirational.

When underway, the Kevlar/fiberglass deep V stepped hull is intended for offshore passages; owners and brokers routinely report a cruising speed near ~30 knots and peak speeds in excess of 50 knots on triple 300–350 hp outboard setups. A Seakeeper installation on one 390 owner's report stated, "It sat in the troughs of the waves as if it was a flat calm day!"—underscoring how

an aftermarket gyro can significantly improve onboard comfort. Routine maintenance follows typical triple outboard patterns: sales histories commonly note full engine services, lower unit or pump replacements, fresh batteries, and service access through a large cockpit hatch, though labor requirements depend on engine layout and added systems.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile deck plan and cockpit cater to day boating, sportfishing, and short cruises.
- Deep V, stepped Kevlar/fiberglass hull provides offshore capability with ~30 kt cruise and >50 kt top speeds when equipped with triple 300–350 hp engines.
- Cabin amenities — queen berth, convertible settee, galley — and frequently listed AC/generator make family overnights comfortable.
- Triple outboard packages require recurring maintenance on lower units, pumps, and batteries.
- Large cockpit hatch grants service access, but time and labor vary by engine configuration and optional equipment.
- True Seakeeper level stabilization is only achieved on boats fitted with the aftermarket gyro unit.

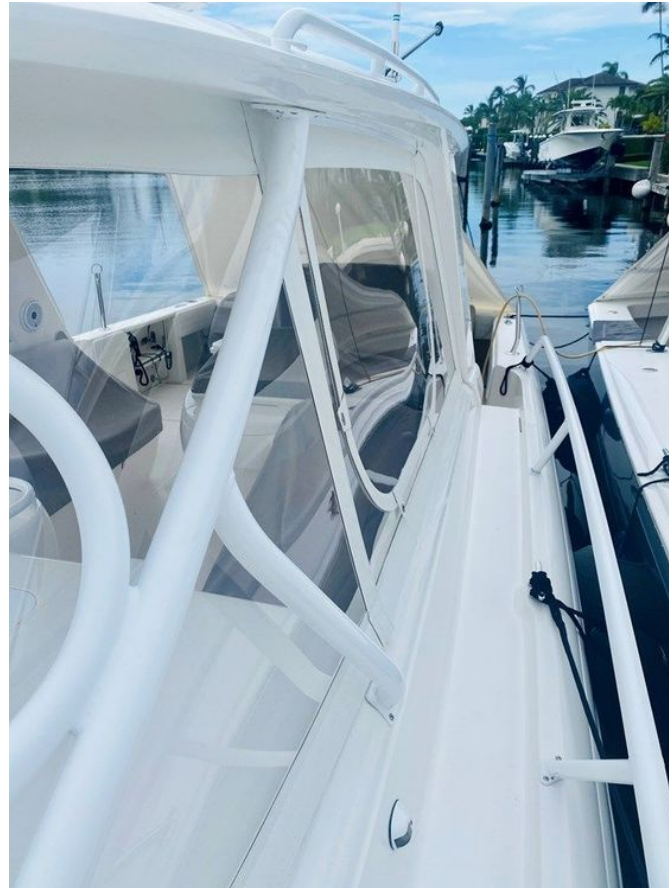
