475 Sport Yacht by INTREPID POWERBOATS INC is a versatile motor yacht engineered for confident coastal passages and quick weekend getaways, marrying onboard comfort with the seaworthiness expected of a true cruiser built on a resilient fiberglass build. Listed by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov.

Selecting a 475 Sport Yacht

Opt for this model if you prioritize quad-outboard power, low-complexity maintenance, and sensible cruising accommodations on a 47-foot hull. Its 13 ft (4.17 m) beam, single head, and sturdy construction make it a solid choice for owners who want an athletic motor yacht that still conveys the leisurely feel of a proper cruiser.

Questions and Answers

Q: What is the yacht type of the 475 Sport Yacht? A: It is a **motor yacht** categorized in the **cruiser** segment and constructed on a **fiberglass build** platform.

Q: What powers this model? A: The **engines** are four Mercury **Outboards** (engine count: 4), fueled by **Gas/Petrol**, offering lively performance with relatively simple servicing requirements.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: **LOA** measures 47 ft (14.33 m), **beam** is 13

ft (4.17 m), and **draft (max)** is 9.843 ft (3 m), delivering a stable foundation for a performance-oriented cruiser.

Q: What onboard capacities and amenities stand out? A: The yacht includes **1 head**, a **fuel capacity** of 483 gal, and a **water capacity** of 100 gal, well matched to active day-boat use and short-term cruising aboard this motor yacht.

Owner Experience Review

Buyers often select the 475 Sport Yacht from INTREPID POWERBOATS INC for family-oriented cruising, offshore fishing days, and brisk island hops on weekends. The interior plan supports day-to-overnight use with a mid-cabin layout, a galley, and a head sized to accommodate four to six people, while the cockpit and helm deck provide ample room for entertaining, fishing setups, or light charter duties. Owners consistently praise the helm ergonomics and sightlines, and the salon and cabin spaces are noted as generous for this size range.

In terms of seakeeping, reviewers have ranked its performance in chop and offshore conditions among the class leaders. The stepped hull combined with the quad-outboard layout produces a secure, relatively dry ride and a helm feel that recalls a center-console while offering more refined yacht-like behavior. Reported numbers from BoatTEST include an approximate 4.4-second time to plane, a WOT around 58 mph with quad outboards, and a comfortable cruise in the high 30s mph.

Owning one requires a mindful maintenance plan. While outboards simplify mechanical access compared with inboard installations, four engines increase the number of service intervals and ongoing engine-related expenses; many examples are fitted with quad Yamaha F350/F425s, and brokers frequently document repowers. Pre-owned listings often list refits or replacements for generators, air-conditioning systems, electronics, and upholstery—normal lifecycle items prospective buyers should budget for.

Pros and Cons

- Excellent handling in chop and offshore, with a stable, relatively dry ride.
- Strong performance: planes in about 4.4 seconds, runs near 58 mph WOT with quad outboards, and cruises comfortably in the high 30s mph.
- Spacious cockpit/helm deck and an overnight-capable mid-cabin, galley, and head suit family cruising and entertaining.
- Quad outboards mean more service points and higher recurring engine maintenance costs.
- Four engines add complexity even though outboards improve mechanical access compared with inboards.
- Many pre-owned examples show generator, AC, electronics, or upholstery refits that buyers should plan for.
