OVERVIEW

The 322 Cuddy from Intrepid delivers twin outboard propulsion and compact overnight accommodations on a versatile, go anywhere platform. Positioned as a motor yacht in the sport fisherman category and built on a proven fiberglass and plastic foundation, it marries brisk performance, fuel efficiency, and user friendly comfort.

Selecting a 322 Cuddy

Choose the 322 Cuddy when you want a compact, capable boat that offers two person overnighting and the thrust of twin Intrepid-specified Yamaha outboards. With a 30 ft (9.14 m) LOA, a 9 ft (2.77 m) beam and a typical cruise speed of 28 knots, this motor yacht is well suited to anglers and weekend boaters who prioritize fast passages, simple systems, and a small marina footprint.

Features of the Model

- Twin Yamaha outboards (Gas, Outboard) providing reliable performance with a comfortable cruise around 28 knots and a top end near 42 knots
- Overnight capability for two with a single head for practical short term stays
- Sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull combined with a fiberglass deck for long term durability and low maintenance
- A purposeful, fisherman focused layout that adapts easily between serious angling and casual dayboating

Q: What type of boat is the 322 Cuddy? A: It is configured as a motor yacht with a clear sport fisherman orientation, built on a resilient fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: What are the performance numbers? A: Powered by twin Yamaha outboards, the 322 Cuddy typically cruises at **28 knots (32.22 mph)** and can reach approximately **42 knots (48.33 mph)** at full throttle.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: Length overall is **30 ft (9.14 m)** , beam measures **9 ft (2.77 m)** , and maximum draft is **8.202 ft (2.5 m)** .

Q: What onboard amenities are included? A: The boat offers **accommodations for 2 , 1 head , 30 gal** of fresh water capacity, and a fiberglass deck atop a fiberglass and plastic hull.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and brokers commonly describe the 322 Cuddy from Intrepid (1996–2004) as a multi role boat that moves easily between offshore fishing missions and family day trips. Its deep V, stepped hull consistently receives praise for delivering a smooth, relatively dry ride in heavier seas; one broker even described it as "slicing through rough offshore conditions with a ride so smooth it feels like you're cheating." Real world cruising speeds commonly sit in the mid 20s knots, and reported top speeds tend to fall in the low to mid 30s, varying with installed power.

Aboard, the design places a roomy cockpit opposite a compact cabin. The small cuddy contains a V berth and an electric head adequate for two overnight guests, though most owners call the space cozy rather than spacious. Around deck, owners point to the walkaround beam (roughly 9'1"), wraparound coaming, in floor storage/fish boxes, a forward L shaped lounge, and a removable aft bench as features that allow quick transitions between a

clean fishing platform and a social dayboat.

Because the design dates to the late 1990s/early 2000s, many hulls have been modernized. Numerous listings note repowers—frequently to twin 300 hp Yamahas during refits—and routine updates typically include electronics, upholstery, and battery/charger replacements. While there are no prominent, repeated structural failure reports tied to this model in public sale listings, a comprehensive pre-purchase survey remains recommended for any vessel of this vintage.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V, stepped hull produces a smooth, relatively dry ride in rough offshore conditions.
- Versatile deck layout with a forward L lounge and removable aft bench adapts for both fishing and social cruising.
- Typical cruise speeds are in the mid 20s knots with reported top ends in the low to mid 30s, subject to installed power.
- Cuddy cabin with V berth and electric head is compact and best suited for short overnights for two.
- As a 1996–2004 design, many boats will either require or already have updates to electronics, upholstery, and batteries.
- Performance depends heavily on power package and overall condition, so speeds can vary significantly between individual boats.
