OVERVIEW

The 407 Cuddy from Intrepid is a multi-purpose motor yacht built on a tried-and-true fiberglass construction foundation. Measuring 40 ft overall with an 11 ft beam, it combines the punch and redundancy of triple outboards with durable, low-maintenance fiberglass surfaces. Represented by Shestakov Yacht Sales, it's tailored for owners seeking uncomplicated performance and capability in a compact 40-foot platform.

Selecting a 407 Cuddy

Opting for the 407 Cuddy typically reflects a desire for a 40-foot layout that mixes the simplicity and acceleration of three outboards with substantial fuel and water reserves. If a 400-gallon fuel tank, 50 gallons of fresh water, and a solid fiberglass construction fit your cruising or fishing plans, the 407 Cuddy should be on your shortlist. Q: What type of yacht is the 407 Cuddy? A: It's a motor yacht manufactured on a sturdy fiberglass construction platform by Intrepid. Notable dimensions are an **LOA of 40 ft (12.19 m)** and a **beam of 11 ft (3.38 m)** .

Q: What engines power the 407 Cuddy? A: The vessel is propelled by **triple Mercury outboards** , offering brisk acceleration and the practical maintenance profile typical of outboard installations.

Owner Experience Review

Owners operate the 407 Cuddy from Intrepid on varied missions: family weekenders with genuine overnight capability, offshore sportfishing, and island-to-island cruising. The “spacious cuddy cabin” is more than a place to nap — it includes a queen berth amidships, a forward settee that converts for additional berths, a compact galley, and a stand-up shower/head, making realistic four-person sleeping arrangements feasible. Owners frequently cite high-quality fit-and-finish — often described as best-in-class — and hullside windows that enhance interior brightness and a finished feel after long days on the water.

When underway, the 407 Cuddy is widely reported as exceptionally quick; professional tests have shown a top speed near 58 mph with triple 400s. Equally important to owners is its dry, composed ride and surefooted handling in choppy conditions thanks to the deep-V hull form, plus a responsive feel at cruise. Owners note fine-tuning trim tabs and, where installed, a Seakeeper to further improve seakeeping — features that resonate with serious anglers as well.

Maintenance realities mirror the performance package: three outboards mean

more routine service items and higher ongoing costs, and listings often reflect scheduled 1,000-hour maintenance. Ownership logs regularly show lower-unit servicing and painting, prop swaps, battery replacements, and periodic Fischer Panda generator maintenance. Some sellers emphasize an “open checkbook approach to maintenance,” and many owners express strong brand loyalty: “We’ve become Intrepid owners for life, and every Intrepid owner I know says the same thing.”

Pros and Cons

- Remarkably fast with a verified top near 58 mph on triple 400s, while remaining composed and responsive at cruising speed.
- Smooth, dry ride and predictable handling in chop courtesy of the deep-V hull and best-in-class fit-and-finish.
- Cuddy cabin supports bona fide weekending with a queen berth, convertible forward settee, compact galley, and stand-up shower/head.
- Triple-outboard propulsion increases routine service frequency and overall maintenance expense.
- Ownership records commonly indicate planned 1,000-hour engine services along with recurring lower-unit work and prop replacements.
- Batteries and the Fischer Panda generator need periodic servicing to keep overnight systems fully operational.
