OVERVIEW

The 407 Nomad FE from Intrepid fuses the nimble handling of a motor yacht with the rugged capabilities of a true sport fisherman. Equipped with triple Mercury outboards, built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull, and specified with practical tankage, it's engineered to satisfy both anglers and cruising owners. Selecting a 407 Nomad FE

Opting for the 407 Nomad FE prioritizes adaptability and raw thrust. At 40 ft (12.19 m) LOA, the 407 Nomad FE delivers the acceleration and handling expected from a motor yacht, while its sport fisherman lineage equips it for serious days on the fishing grounds. With a triple Mercury outboard package running on gas/petrol, large fuel stowage, and adequate freshwater reserves, it's an appealing choice for owners seeking a single boat that performs as both a capable fisher and a comfortable cruiser — all backed by Intrepid craftsmanship and the brokerage support of Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of boat is the 407 Nomad FE? A: It's a versatile motor yacht that retains genuine sport fisherman function from Intrepid, offering a balance between speed and fishability.

Q: What powers the boat? A: The model is driven by three Mercury outboards — a **triple outboard** arrangement operating on **gas/petrol** for brisk acceleration and straightforward maintenance.

Q: What is the size of the boat? A: The **LOA** is 40 ft (12.19 m), providing a

footprint well-suited to both nearshore cruising and offshore passages.

Q: What are the fuel and water capacities? A: **Fuel capacity** is 603 gal to support extended range, and **water capacity** is 50 gal for onboard comfort and short cruises.

Q: What is the hull and deck made from? A: The hull is constructed of fiberglass and plastic for durability and longevity, and the **deck** is fiberglass for a resilient, low-maintenance finish.

Owner Experience Review

Across published sea trials and brokerage listings, the 407 Nomad FE by Intrepid reads as a true multi-role center console: substantial fishing functionality with a large cockpit, insulated fish boxes, dual baitwells, and generous rod storage; comfortable family amenities such as a forward island lounge/sunpad and guest seating; and easy dive and watersports access via the port dive/boarding door with its fold-under ladder. The FE configuration's front entry head and a cabin offering roughly 6'6" of headroom make short overnighting feasible while maintaining the open deck flow and utility expected of a center console, which also makes it suitable as a high-quality tender for larger yachts.

On the water, testers commonly report a composed, stable ride that remains calm in beam seas and while drifting, with steering characterized as smooth — reviewers even liken it to 'buttah' — and throttle response that is immediate. In triple-outboard setups the boat delivers genuinely brisk performance; a published test using Yamaha 425 XTOs recorded about 66 mph at WOT and roughly a 3-second time to plane. Helm ergonomics receive strong marks as well, with features like an adjustable helm platform/elevator, unobstructed sightlines, and the elevated fit and finish associated with Intrepid.

Maintenance notes tend to revolve around the triple outboards—regular service intervals and warranty management are ongoing considerations, and if equipped, a gyro unit such as a Seakeeper introduces its own maintenance schedule. Access to mechanical systems and the bilge is generally straightforward, and public sources do not cite recurring, model-specific defects; one commonly noted practical shortcoming is that the foldaway boarding steps are fitted only on the port side. These observations derive from published tests and listings rather than an extensive owner survey, but they collectively portray the 407 Nomad FE as a capable, comfortable, and high-performance center console.

Pros and Cons

- Smooth, stable ride with precise steering reviewers described as 'buttah'.
- High performance in triple outboard configurations, with a published test near 66 mph WOT and ~3 seconds to plane.
- Versatile deck and FE cabin layout supports serious fishing, family cruising, diving, and use as a tender.
- Triple outboards increase routine service costs and require vigilant warranty upkeep.
- Foldaway boarding steps are located only on the port side, which some owners find inconvenient.
- Optional gyro/Seakeeper and other heavy stabilization systems add additional maintenance demands if installed.
