The 427 Nomad FE from Intrepid is a high-end motor yacht built on a Deep Vee hull with a fiberglass and plastic hull. Specified with quad Mercury outboards, generous fuel and water reserves, and a single enclosed head, it's engineered to perform offshore while offering refined day-boat comforts, with full brokerage support from Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Q: What category does the 427 Nomad FE belong to? A: It is a motor yacht realized in a center console yacht format, constructed to fiberglass and plastic standards.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: The vessel's **LOA** measures 42 ft (12.8 m) while the **beam** spans 12 ft (3.86 m), offering generous working and leisure space typical of a center console layout.

Q: What propulsion and fuel does it use? A: The 427 Nomad FE is powered by **four Mercury outboards** and operates on **Gas/Petrol** , delivering robust performance and widely available service options.

Q: What capacities and amenities are on board? A: The boat carries **770 gal** of fuel and **80 gal** of fresh water. It is equipped with **1 head** to support overnighting and day-use comfort.

Owner Experience Review

Owners who step aboard the 427 Nomad FE from Intrepid frequently note its split personality: a serious offshore fishing tool that's equally suited to relaxed owner-operator cruising. The layout supports true 360° angling with capacious fish boxes and angler-centric options such as outriggers and thoughtful rod storage, while the wave-cutting bow and single-stepped hull contribute to a relatively dry, confident ride. Handling is reported as steady and predictable at speed with the suggested outboard packages, and typical real-world performance figures often cited include a ~38-knot cruise with potential top ends into the mid-50s depending on propulsion choices.

When the agenda turns to family cruising, the forward lounge, generous cockpit, and a fully equipped galley nestled between the hardtop arches transform the boat into a comfortable day cruiser. The FE's front-entry console, complete with three-across helm seating and a wraparound windshield, produces a secure, ergonomic helm station, and the sizable console head exhibits a finish level influenced by the brand's Panacea heritage. Forward, a large foredeck sunpad with adjustable backrest and deep in-deck storage/fish

lockers showcases the model's deliberate mixed-use design. One owner at launch summed it up, saying "this may be the top boat he's ever been on," reflecting the upscale feeling aboard.

For extended coastal passages, owners reference a standard 530-gallon fuel capacity with options to add additional tanks to increase range. The outboard-centric architecture—available in twin, triple, or quad setups from major manufacturers like Mercury, Yamaha, and Suzuki—keeps servicing within familiar high-horsepower outboard norms, and some early resale offerings mention Mercury Platinum extended warranty coverage. The open transom with outboard mounting simplifies rigging and maintenance compared with inboard solutions. Given the model's introduction around 2022–2023, long-term independent ownership data is limited and no significant systemic failures have been reported to date.

Pros and Cons

- Predictable, stable offshore manners with a wave-slicing entry and a single-stepped hull that tends to keep the deck relatively dry.
- Versatile mixed-use design that combines 360° fishability, large fish storage, a comfortable forward lounge, and a full galley for family-focused days.
- Standard 530-gallon fuel provision with the possibility to add extra tanks for longer coastal ranges.
- Limited long-term independent ownership feedback due to the model's 2022–2023 introduction window.
- High-horsepower outboards require consistent maintenance, and many owners pursue extended warranty coverage.
- Cruise and top speeds depend on the chosen engine package and installation, rather than a single fixed performance figure.
