## OVERVIEW

---

Purpose-built for confident passages and quick weekend escapes, the 475 Sport Yacht from Intrepid is a high-performance motor yacht featuring a fiberglass hull. With quad Yamaha outboards and thoughtfully sized tanks and accommodations, it appeals to owners prioritizing speed and capability. Work with Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov to explore available examples.

## Selecting a 475 Sport Yacht

---

Select the 475 Sport Yacht if you want a vessel that balances high-speed capability with sensible cruising amenities. At 47 ft (14.48 m) LOA, a 13 ft (4.17 m) beam, and a maximum draft of 9.843 ft (3 m), it provides the presence of a sport motor yacht while leveraging outboard propulsion for efficiency and serviceability. Its 29 gross tons and rugged fiberglass hull underpin both performance and offshore confidence.

If peak speed matters, the boat's typical cruise of 35 kn (40.28 mph) and a top end around 52 kn (59.84 mph) are compelling, and its 483-gallon fuel tank together with 100 gallons of freshwater make longer days and weekend trips realistic. ## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What kind of performance can I expect from the 475 Sport Yacht? A: Expect bold **performance** : roughly 35 kn (40.28 mph) for cruising and as much as 52 kn (59.84 mph) at the top end, consistent with its high-speed motor yacht intentions.

Q: Which engines power the boat? A: The yacht is fitted with four **Yamaha outboard** engines running on **Gas/Petrol** , offering strong acceleration and ease of service access.

Q: What are the key capacities for trips? A: For extended day runs, the **capacities** include about 483 gallons of fuel and 100 gallons of freshwater, with one head providing onboard convenience.

Q: What is the draft, and where can I operate? A: The maximum **draft** is 9.843 ft (3 m). Always confirm local depth and tidal conditions before planning port entries or shallow-water routes.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners of the 475 Sport Yacht by Intrepid commonly praise its adaptability: it works well for family day trips and island runs, serious offshore fishing

excursions, and social weekends with a roomy topside entertainment area.

On the water, the transverse stepped hull is frequently credited with providing a more yacht like motion and confident offshore manners; many owners report predictable chine entries and reassuring behavior in head seas.

Belowdecks, the cabin and galley are often described as more refined than typical around this size—one owner labeled it “one of the most impressive cabins I’ve seen.” Typical listings show three berth configurations, a proper head, and additions like a Seakeeper and a full galley, making the layout comfortable for couples or guests on extended weekends.

The trade offs focus on ownership costs and maintenance: four high power outboards increase operating and service expenses, fuel consumption rises sharply at wide open throttle, and several owners note that the large outboard installation can limit easy engine access for DIY work. Many listings therefore emphasize recent major services or current extended engine warranties.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Smooth, assured offshore ride produced by the stepped hull with predictable handling in head seas.
- High-performance capability and strong cruise speeds enabled by the quad outboards.
- Cabin and galley appointments feel yacht like, often offered with three berth layouts and a true head for weekend comfort.
- Elevated operating and maintenance costs associated with four high horsepower outboards, with significant fuel burn at WOT.
- The large outboard bank can restrict engine access, making some maintenance tasks more demanding for owners.
- Ownership is improved by diligent major service intervals and warranty

management, a point noted in many sale listings.

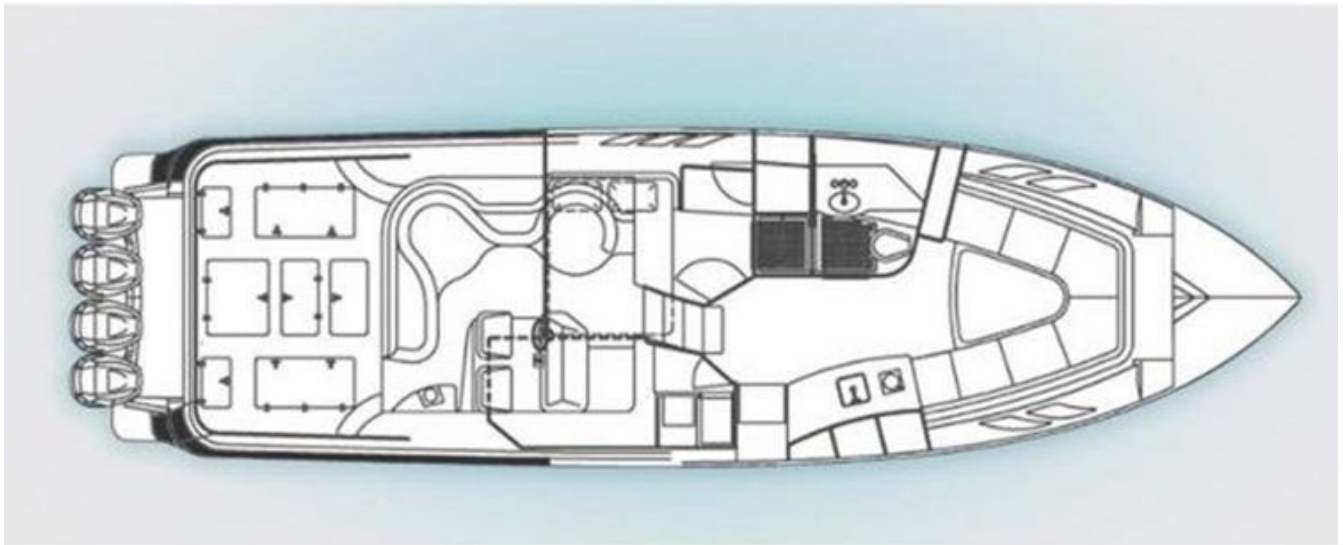
