Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers commonly describe the Open Fisherman by Invincible Boats as a purpose-built fishing platform capable of tournament work and swift bluewater passages. On the water it accelerates with minimal bow rise, and the stepped V ventilated tunnel hull provides a flat feel, predictable roll into turns, and composure at speed. Typical owner-reported cruise speeds are around 31–33 mph at approximately 3,000 rpm, with some configurations showing mid 40s cruising and claimed top speeds near 75 mph; the large fuel capacity and efficient running support extended days offshore.

The single-level deck layout, wide side decks, and recessed bow rails create genuine 360° fishability while making movement fore and aft secure during the action. The console contains a spacious, fully lined head, and the boat is fitted with multiple insulated fishboxes and ample under deck storage; removable seating allows owners to convert between an open fishing deck for tournament days and comfortable seating for family cruising or sandbar outings.

Owner feedback emphasizes ease of service: accessible fuse blocks, a clear NMEA 2000 backbone and tidy routing for bilge, fuel, and sea chest systems with filters, pumps, and seacocks placed for easy inspection. Construction notes—such as a vacuum bagged, cored hull using 100% vinylester resin and an integrated molded stringer grid—are often cited as safeguards against

long term issues. Not all commentary is uniformly positive: some forum comparisons suggest a rival may have a slight edge in finish quality and long term durability, and buyer anecdotes have mentioned dealer responsiveness and wait times as purchase considerations; one delivery report referenced a Fort Lauderdale Boat Show acquisition around \$525k with additional equipment added thereafter. Despite those caveats, the Open Fisherman is widely regarded as a vessel built for long-range runs and tournament duty while remaining versatile enough for family outings.

Pros and Cons

- Pro: Strong, flat acceleration with low bow rise and predictable high-speed behavior from the stepped V ventilated tunnel hull.
- Pro: Efficient cruising and large fuel tanks enable long-range offshore and tournament operations.
- Pro: True 360° single level deck, roomy head, several insulated fishboxes, and well-organized stowage.
- Con: Some forum commentary favors a competitor for finish and perceived long-term durability.
- Con: Reported dealer response times and waiting periods have influenced some buyers' decisions.
- Con: Initial purchase price plus added options can be significant; one forum post referenced a roughly \$525k show purchase with extras added afterward.

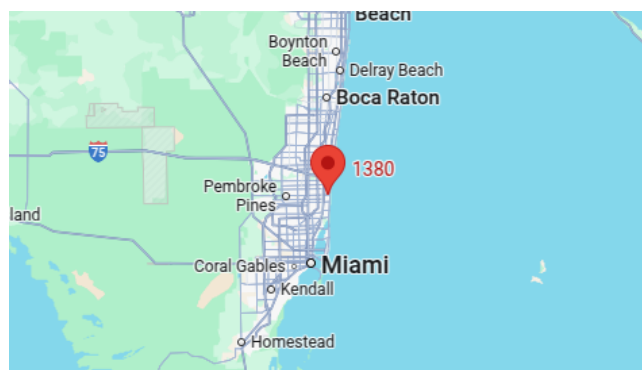
