The Viper 130 from ISA YACHTS is a fast, high-performance motor yacht built in fiberglass construction with a planing hull form, designed to marry thrilling speed with upscale onboard living. Measuring 130 ft (39.62 m) overall with a 25 ft (7.8 m) beam, it provides a refined platform for rapid cruising and comfortable hospitality. Q: What are the performance figures of the Viper 130? A: The yacht achieves a **maximum speed** of 35 kn (40.28 mph) and a **cruising speed** of 26 kn (29.92 mph), aided by a planing hull that supports efficient high-speed passage making.

Q: How many people can the yacht accommodate? A: The layout offers **accommodations** for 10 guests with **6 heads** , together with **3 crew cabins** to house professional crew and maintain service levels.

Owner Experience Review

For buyers attracted to outright speed and easy access to shallow cruising grounds, the Viper 130 from ISA YACHTS is presented as a carbon fibre planing sport yacht featuring triple MAN ~2200 hp powerplants driving two

waterjets with an added MJP booster. Manufacturer and press materials report a circa 35 knot top speed and a comfortable cruising range in the mid 20s (manufacturer-cited cruise of about 26 knots), which makes rapid coastal hops a practical option.

Aboard, published coverage notes accommodation for up to 10 guests across five staterooms including a full beam owner suite with dual bathrooms, along with typically large-yacht features uncommon on high-speed platforms: floor to ceiling glazing in the saloon, a three tier aft cockpit, fold out side balconies, a foredeck plunge pool, a roughly 5 m tender garage, and expansive alfresco entertaining areas. The model is positioned in the market as an owner operated performance yacht rather than a primary charter-centric design.

Caveats are explicit: as of July 2, 2026, independent sea trials and extended owner reports covering seakeeping, helm feedback, noise and vibration levels, crew ergonomics, or maintenance experience are not available; the initial hull has been sold and hull #2 is under construction. Prospective owners should anticipate maintenance demands associated with triple high output diesels and waterjet systems, plus the specialist parts and service logistics common to carbon fibre planing superyachts. No patterns of recurring faults, engine-room access issues, or audited operating costs have been published so far.

Pros and Cons

- Claimed ~35 knot top speed and mid 20s knot cruise enable rapid coastal passages.
- Shallow ~1.55 m draft with waterjets broadens access to Bahamas and Caribbean style anchorages.
- Five stateroom layout and big boat amenities (balconies, plunge pool, large

glazing, ~5 m tender garage) support comfortable private cruising.

- No independent sea trial or owner operator feedback has been published as of July 2, 2026.
- Triple high power engines and waterjets imply specialist maintenance and parts logistics.
- Long term reliability, noise/vibration levels, and operating costs remain unverified for this new model.
