OVERVIEW

Built to fuel high-energy days at sea, the Italyure 38 Sport from ITALYURE YACHTS is a streamlined motor yacht in the motor yachts segment, built on a fiberglass and plastic hull. Represented by Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov, it combines eye-catching velocity, refined lines, and practical usability.

Selecting a Italyure 38 Sport

Opt for the Italyure 38 Sport when you want blistering performance—peaking at 74 knots—paired with the dependability and straightforward serviceability of twin Mercury outboards. With a compact 39 ft LOA and an 11 ft beam, it delivers an accessible footprint for owners who value speed without sacrificing manageability. As a modern motor yacht within the broader motor yachts category, it excels as a fast day boat, a premium tender, or a nimble coastal cruiser where simplicity and pace are priorities.

Features of the Model

- High-octane performance: capable of reaching up to 74 knots (85.16 mph) for swift transfers and exhilarating runs.
- Twin Mercury outboards deliver crisp handling, straightforward maintenance, and accessible servicing.
- Gas/petrol propulsion keeps overall weight low and provides energetic acceleration.
- Well-proportioned dimensions (39 ft LOA, 11 ft beam) for a blend of stability, agility, and easy marina handling.
- Robust construction with a fiberglass and plastic hull and a fiberglass deck designed for longevity.

- Sleeping provision for 1, offering a sheltered area for gear storage or an occasional overnight pause.

Q: What type of yacht is the Italyure 38 Sport? A: It is a **motor yacht** listed in the **motor yachts market** .

Q: What is the **top speed** ? A: The maximum speed is **74 knots (85.16 mph)** ,

offering high-performance passages.

Q: What **engines** power the boat? A: It is driven by **2 x Mercury outboards** running on **Gas/Petrol** , providing responsive acceleration and easier servicing.

Q: What are the key **dimensions** ? A: LOA is **39 ft (11.95 m)** and beam is **11 ft (3.59 m)** , providing a stable yet nimble platform.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and charterers commonly describe the Italyure 38 Sport as an excellent day-boat for Mediterranean destinations—places like the Amalfi Coast, Capri, and Mallorca—where its layout comfortably supports social outings and family cruising. The Sport configuration is optimized for outboards, typically in the 2×300–2×350 hp range, and dealer reports highlight quiet, composed cruising, notably with Suzuki 350 DuoProp setups, delivering handling reminiscent of a RIB but with more refinement. That combination appeals to buyers stepping up from RIBs who want similar agility but lower ongoing costs.

Inside, the open-plan saloon and C-shaped convertible sofa pair with a versatile cockpit that easily transforms into a large social zone, which is why the model is popular for day-charter operations and weekend escapes for groups of around 8–10 guests. Guests frequently praise the onboard hospitality—“Roberto e Yan sono stati assolutamente fantastici!! Ci hanno fornito una crociera davvero a 5 stelle.” Depending on the chosen layout, accommodation typically includes a single cabin and a roomy head, with some variants featuring a separate shower compartment.

Upkeep tends to reflect the outboard-centric design: the Sport's propulsion is generally viewed as lower-maintenance than comparable inboard or sterndrive arrangements, helping control running expenses. As ITALYURE YACHTS is a relatively new builder, owner networks and dealer/service footprints beyond Italy are still expanding, so prospective buyers should confirm local parts availability and service support. Some listings indicate manufacturer warranty on recent examples (for instance, a 2023 model with coverage through April 2026), but buyers must verify the exact warranty terms and regional service provisions.

Pros and Cons

- Responsive, RIB-like handling and quiet, smooth cruising are reported with common 2×300–2×350 hp outboard installations.
- The adaptable cockpit and open-plan interior with a C-shaped convertible sofa make it well suited to social day boating for groups of about 8–10.
- Outboard propulsion is positioned to reduce maintenance and running costs, attractive to owners moving up from RIBs.
- The single-cabin arrangement, with a separate shower available only on some versions, may not satisfy buyers seeking multi-cabin accommodations.
- As a young builder, dealer and service coverage outside Italy is still maturing; confirm local parts and support before purchase.
- Warranty availability and scope differ by boat and market, so verify coverage and service access for your region.
