The 10.5 Leader S2 is ideal for buyers wanting a compact yet capable motor yacht that transitions easily from daytime outings to overnight stays. Measuring 35 ft (10.95 m) overall, this twin engine Jeanneau walkaround is powered by Yamaha outboards to offer straightforward ownership and operation. With gasoline fueling, a fiberglass deck, and a single head, it strikes a practical balance between simplicity, comfort, and family friendly cruising for weekends or day trips.

Q: What type of yacht is the 10.5 Leader S2? A: It's a motor yacht configured as a walkaround yacht with a fiberglass-and-plastic hull.

Q: What is the propulsion setup on this model? A: The 10.5 Leader S2 is equipped with **twin outboard** engines—2 Yamaha powerplants—running on **gas/petrol** .

Q: What is the LOA of the boat? A: The **LOA** measures 35 ft (10.95 m), providing

a practical compromise between onboard space and manageability.

Q: How many heads are onboard? A: There is **1 head** , offering the essential facilities for day trips and short weekends.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly choose the 10.5 Leader S2 from Jeanneau for family day cruises and short weekend voyages. Accommodation for four is arranged between a forward V berth and an aft cabin. The spacious cockpit is designed for socializing, featuring a summer galley, a generously sized table, and a sunpad that converts for lounging or extra sleeping area. The outboard configuration supports watersports and light fishing, with Yamaha options commonly specified in the 300–425+ hp range and deck layouts that can accommodate coolers or livewells. As a Series 2 variant that began appearing in listings around 2021, it remains part of Jeanneau’s current offering.

Underway, the Michael Peters deep V hull with a double step profile gives a relatively soft and stable ride for a 34' outboard cruiser, delivering a responsive helm and clear sightlines from the elevated helm position; owners often fit and praise active trim systems such as Zipwake. The boat typically lifts on plane at roughly ~20 mph and, when powered by twin high output Yamahas, accelerates quickly to an efficient cruise and a strong top speed; Sharrow prop retrofits are frequently mentioned for improved performance. Belowdecks, the cabin is compact yet bright and includes a head with shower, though headroom is limited to about 4'9". The sleek push button cabinetry provides concealed storage but sometimes draws “IKEA style” commentary, and a few

users note the helm could benefit from additional grab handles. Maintenance access is a strong point thanks to a large cockpit service hatch that affords near human sized entry to pumps, tanks, wiring, and the optional generator, but cosmetic and trim parts can suffer long lead times. If you plan to operate A/C underway, most recommend fitting a generator rather than relying solely on an inverter.

Pros and Cons

- Soft, stable ride from the Michael Peters deep V with a double step hull.
- Social cockpit layout with summer galley, large table, and a convertible sunpad.
- Large cockpit/service hatch offers near human sized access to major systems.
- Cabin headroom is limited at about 4'9", reducing comfort for taller guests.
- Cosmetic/trim parts can have long lead times due to supply chain and spec.
- To run A/C underway reliably, a generator is strongly recommended over inverter only.

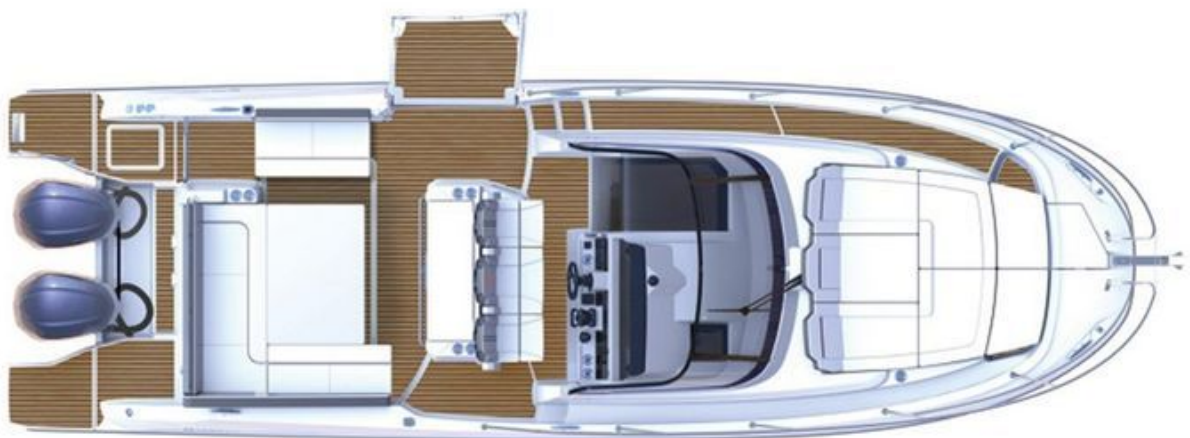

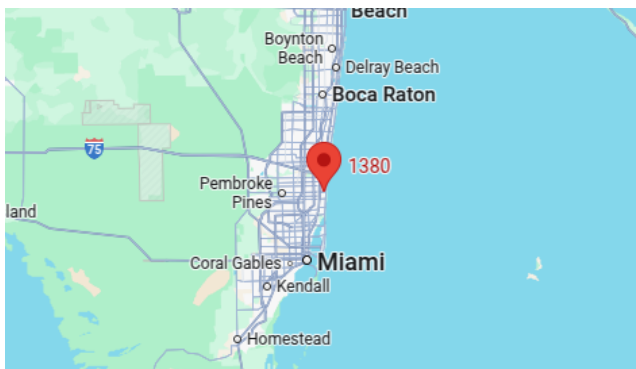
