OVERVIEW

Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov, the 10.5 Walkaround from Jeanneau combines assured handling with sensible onboard comforts. Designed as a versatile motor yacht for a range of cruising missions, it is constructed on a well-proven fiberglass construction platform.

Selecting a 10.5 Walkaround

Deciding on the ideal specification for the 10.5 Walkaround depends largely on how you intend to use it — quick day trips with spirited pace, short weekend passages, or relaxed family coastal cruising. With a comfortable cruise around 30 knots and a reported top end near 42 knots, and compact dimensions (35 ft LOA, 10 ft beam), it maneuvers readily in tight marinas and on trailer-friendly ramps. Questions and Answers

Q: How fast is the 10.5 Walkaround? A: It achieves a **cruise speed** of

approximately 30 kn (34.52 mph) and a **top speed** around 42 kn (48.33 mph), aided by its Deep Vee hull form.

Q: What engines power this model? A: The 10.5 Walkaround is driven by twin **Yamaha outboards** (2 engines), running on **Gas/Petrol** for lively acceleration and straightforward servicing.

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: The boat is built on a **Deep Vee** hull using fiberglass construction, and the **deck material** is Fiberglass to resist wear and reduce upkeep.

Q: What are the key dimensions and capacities? A: **LOA** 35 ft (10.67 m), **beam** 10 ft (3.22 m), **draft** 7.939 ft (2.4199 m); **fuel capacity** 106 gal and **water capacity** 42 gal.

Q: How is the model classified? A: It is listed in the motor yacht segment and specifically in the cruiser category, built with a hull aligned to fiberglass and plastic construction. Shestakov Yacht Sales and Andrey Shestakov can explain how this placement serves your boating needs.

Owner Experience Review

Owners typically use the 10.5 Walkaround from Jeanneau as a flexible platform for family coastal outings with groups of about eight to ten, and as a comfortable weekend boat for two to four. The cockpit and foredeck function as the main social zones, featuring a substantial fore sunpad and an aft saloon that converts for lounging — ideal for day trips. Below decks the interior is bright and practical, offering a galley, an enclosed head with separate shower, and a saloon that converts to provide up to four berths for short stays; though headroom is modest, it is in line with expectations for this class. The model is also a common sight in Mediterranean charter operations, a testament to its straightforward, user-focused layout—summed up by an owner’s remark: “A

really well thought out boat. Great design and usability.”

On the water, sea trials and owner reports praise the Michael Peters deep V with stepped sections for a composed, forgiving ride. Typical cruising in many owner reports is nearer 20 knots, while higher powered installations have pushed recorded top speeds past 40 knots (one trial logged 44 knots), and the twin outboard setup delivers a lively, sporty feel. Some owners note sensitivity to wind and swell when at anchor. Routine maintenance aligns with twin outboard ownership—impeller changes, gear oil service, and electrical checks—with occasional dealer assistance required for integrated electronics and joystick systems; access to mechanical spaces is tighter than on larger cabin yachts. A handful of owners have mentioned variability in materials and fit and finish, but no pervasive, model specific mechanical failures are commonly reported.

Pros and Cons

- Soft, stable ride at planing speeds from the Michael Peters deep V with stepped sections.
- Sporty handling and strong performance on twin outboards, with typical cruise ~20 kt and top speeds above 40 kt reported.
- Practical layout for families and weekenders, with galley, enclosed head, and up to four berths.
- Below deck headroom is limited for adults on longer stays.
- Some owners report variable materials and fit and finish quality.
- Can be sensitive to wind and swell when at anchor.
