The DB37 OB from Jeanneau takes outboard propulsion and places it on a sophisticated, roomy platform — combining nimble handling with ownership practicality. Built as a motor yacht on a fiberglass construction hull, it marries twin Yamaha outboards to thoughtfully scaled dimensions for adaptable coastal use. ## Selecting a DB37 OB

---

Deciding on the ideal DB37 OB setup begins with where you intend to cruise and how you'll use the boat. Its 40 ft LOA and 11 ft beam make it easier to dock, store, and slip into crowded harbors, while the 8.749 ft max draft suits many nearshore cruising grounds. Twin outboards deliver shallow-water access and simpler servicing, and the Gas/Petrol powertrain paired with Yamaha units keeps routine maintenance and handling straightforward — attributes that favor day outings and short weekend cruises alike.

Q: What type of yacht is the DB37 OB? A: It is a motor yacht from Jeanneau built on a fiberglass hull and powered by twin Yamaha outboards, delivering **performance** , **efficiency** , and **ease of ownership** .

Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: The DB37 OB measures **LOA 40 ft (12.29 m)** , has a **beam of 11 ft (3.56 m)** , and a **max draft of 8.749 ft**

**(2.6666 m)** , providing a compact footprint that eases marina handling and storage.

Q: Which engines and fuel does it use? A: Propulsion is provided by **two Yamaha Outboard** engines running on **Gas/Petrol** , which together offer **responsive handling** and **straightforward maintenance** .

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners are drawn to the DB37 OB by Jeanneau largely because it prioritizes a dayboat-oriented layout with exceptional social space. The cockpit dominates the experience: drop-down bulwarks extend the usable beam by roughly two meters, flip-up benches transform into a large sunpad, and seating is arranged to accommodate six to eight forward-facing passengers comfortably. The architecture feels deliberately focused on entertaining, swimming, and hanging out at anchor rather than trying to replicate a full-length cruiser below decks.

For overnight use, the DB37 OB performs respectably. It offers two double cabins — an owner’s suite forward and a full-beam midship cabin — plus a separate heads with shower, making short stays for two to four guests practical, though it isn’t designed to substitute for larger cruising yachts’ below-deck comfort. A wet bar on deck concentrates food preparation topside, and the below-deck galley provisions are intentionally modest to support light

meals. Ergonomics and joystick-style controls favor owner-operators seeking low-stress handling, while the convertible seating and layout also lend themselves to chartering or hosting guests.

On the water, drivers report the boat feels lively and composed: responsive at the helm with good grip, typical cruise speeds in the low to mid 20-knot range (around 22–26 knots) and top speeds near 32–33 knots depending on engine choice and installation. The ride is reported as surprisingly forgiving in chop, and the hull's seakeeping in more active conditions receives regular commendation. When equipped with twin Yamaha XTO 450 outboards, performance is robust, although helm noise at planing speed has been measured in the neighborhood of 88–98 dB. Service access is a practical strength — a sliding cockpit section and hydraulic engine-lift arrangement provide full engine access and space configured for options like a generator or Seakeeper. Note the modest fresh-water capacity (roughly 250 L) relative to the large fuel onboard (approximately 960 L for the outboard version) if you intend extended cruising away from marina services. Introduced in 2023, the DB/37 family has not yet accumulated long-term fault trends specific to this model.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Immense, flexible cockpit with drop-down bulwarks and convertible seating ideal for social dayboating.
- Genuine weekender accommodation with two double cabins and a separate heads with shower.
- Deft, responsive handling with a ride that is softer than expected in choppy conditions.
- With twin Yamaha XTO 450 outboards, helm noise is noticeable at planing speeds (about 88–98 dB).
- The hardtop is basic and does not include features such as a sunroof or

skylights.

- Relatively small fresh-water capacity (around 250 L) may limit extended cruising despite substantial fuel capacity (around 960 L on the outboard version).

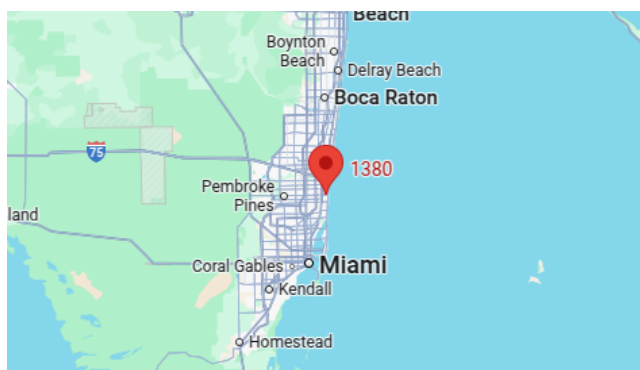
