Presented through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, this design pairs lively outboard propulsion and modern styling to create an elegant platform for day cruising and short overnight escapes.

## Selecting a DB43 OB

---

Deciding on the DB43 OB hinges on adaptability, onboard comfort, and secure handling. The triple Mercury outboards provide quick throttle response, while the 44 ft (13.54 m) LOA and 12 ft (3.81 m) beam deliver substantial guest space. If you prioritize straightforward upkeep, the durability of fiberglass decking, and the flexible performance advantages of outboards, this Jeanneau model will meet those needs.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What type of yacht is the DB43 OB? A: It is positioned in the premium motor yachts segment and recognized as a motor yacht class, combining performance and comfort for day boating and weekend cruising.

Q: What engines power this model? A: The yacht features **three Mercury outboards**, delivering the advantages of **outboard** configuration—responsiveness, serviceability, and shallow water maneuvering

characteristics.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The **LOA is 44 ft (13.54 m)** with a **beam of 12 ft (3.81 m)** and a **minimum draft of 10.663 ft (3.25 m)** , providing a stable platform and generous deck space.

Q: What is the fuel capacity and construction? A: Fuel capacity is **342 gallons** . The hull is a fiberglass and plastic build with **fiberglass deck** , balancing strength, weight, and ease of maintenance.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and charter guests most often use the DB43 OB by Jeanneau for family daytime outings, social entertaining, and short coastal weekend trips. The expansive, adaptable cockpit—with its center island galley, swiveling seating, and drop down side terraces—creates a beach club style aft area ideal for hosting; Jeanneau specifies capacity up to 12. Charter reviews frequently praise the clean, well presented interiors and abundant lounging zones, with comments such as “luxury all the way around” and “plenty of space,” while also noting it’s “not cheap but very good value for money.”

Underway, the Michael Peters hull is credited with dependable seakeeping and confident manners across varied conditions, and the outboard configuration is often described as sporty and responsive. Charterers reinforce this impression with observations like “BEST RIDE EVER,” and they highlight how well the boat tracks through following seas. Advertised performance for the OB specification approaches 40 knots, matching its intended role as a lively dayboat that still offers a composed, comfortable ride.

From an ownership standpoint, the DB43 OB is a relatively new model with no widespread long term problems reported publicly to date. Routine maintenance for the OB variant follows typical outboard service intervals, with generally easier access than inboard setups, and after sales support is channelled through Jeanneau’s dealer network. Prospective buyers considering the inboard alternative should note at least one professional review calling out tighter engine room access, so surveys should include a thorough check of serviceability and access.

## Pros and Cons

- Beach club cockpit with drop down terraces, modular seating, and a center island galley creates a social hub with space for up to 12.
- Sporty, responsive OB handling and solid seakeeping from the Michael Peters hull, with near 40 knot capability reported.
- Two cabins with a separate shower and high quality finish, plus abundant sunpads and a large hydraulic swim platform, suit weekend cruising.
- Renter feedback notes it is not cheap, though considered good value for money.
- Model is relatively new, so long term ownership data is limited.
- If evaluating the inboard variant, reviewers report tighter engine room access and advise inspecting service access during survey.
