## OVERVIEW

---

The 34 Center Console from JUPITER is a purpose-built center console yacht in the motor yacht category. It offers a 34 ft (10.36 m) hull with a 10 ft (3.15 m) beam and is driven by triple Yamaha outboards. With a single head and sizable fuel and water tanks, this model is configured for serious day boating and comfortable coastal runs.

---

## Selecting a 34 Center Console

---

Deciding on the right center console hinges on balancing onboard room, draft, propulsion layout, and tankage. The 34 Center Console provides a 34 ft LOA, a 10 ft beam, and a maximum draft of 9.843 ft (3.0 m), driven by three Yamaha engines. If you need a capable center console yacht within the motor yacht segment that also includes a functioning head and generous tank capacities (390 gal fuel, 50 gal water), this model is worth close consideration.

## Features of the Model

---

- Triple Yamaha propulsion for strong performance and operational redundancy.
- The practicality of a center console design married to the multiuse capability expected of a motor yacht.
- A single head to provide onboard convenience during extended days.
- Tankage sized for active days on the water: 390 gal fuel and 50 gal water.

Q: What is the LOA of the 34 Center Console? A: The **LOA** measures 34 ft (10.36 m).

Q: What are the beam and maximum draft? A: The **beam** is 10 ft (3.15 m), and the maximum **draft** is 9.843 ft (3.0 m).

Q: What type of yacht is this model? A: It is a center console yacht categorized under motor yacht.

Q: How many engines and what brand does it use? A: The boat is powered by three **engines** from **Yamaha** .

Q: What are the key onboard capacities and amenities? A: **Fuel capacity** is 390 gal and **water capacity** is 50 gal; there is one **head** for onboard convenience.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and reviewers commonly praise the 34 Center Console from JUPITER for delivering a dry, composed ride in chop and predictable handling. Sea trials indicate it gets on plane in about four seconds, accelerates from 0–35 mph in roughly 12 seconds, and handles comfortably in 2–3 ft seas. Published performance figures suggest an efficient cruise near 32.6 mph at 3,000 rpm, with a top speed approaching 64.4 mph when fitted with triple 300s, reinforcing its brisk, sporty character at the helm.

In everyday operation the boat transitions neatly between offshore tournament performance and family-friendly cruising. Anglers appreciate full 360° fishability and generous fishboxes, while families make use of the forward lounge and expansive bow seating for sandbar and day-trip enjoyment. Owners also highlight the comfortable cruising speeds and abundant fuel capacity for long day runs and extended coastal hops, and brokers often point out its capability as a tender or dive platform.

Helm layout supports twin 15-inch screens, comfortable seating, unobstructed sightlines, and ample legroom, and newer iterations include a compact head for quick changes. Maintenance is typically straightforward: routine Yamaha outboard servicing is common, many boats carry extended Yamaha warranties, and the roomy lazarette gives easy access to baitwell pumps, through-hulls, and hydraulic components. On more recent builds, Seakeeper Ride is offered or standard, which introduces additional service items compared with the base configuration.

## Pros and Cons

- A dry, solid ride with assured handling, quick planing, and sharp turning noted in evaluations.
- The forward lounge and expansive bow seating create a true lounge area ideal for families and sandbar outings.
- Large lazarette affords easy access to pumps, through-hulls, and hydraulic gear for simplified maintenance.
- The head compartment is compact and most suitable for quick, practical use.
- Inclusion of Seakeeper Ride on newer builds brings extra maintenance tasks versus base models.
- Options and features vary over a long production run, so buyers should confirm items like Seakeeper Ride and specific head layouts.
