OVERVIEW

Built by JUPITER, the 34 HFS is a flexible center-console motor yacht designed on a robust fiberglass and plastic hull with a fiberglass deck and twin Yamaha outboards running on gas. Listed and handled by Andrey Shestakov of Shestakov Yacht Sales, this 34 foot model combines practical onboard capacities with a clean, efficient arrangement for a variety of uses.

Selecting a 34 HFS

Opt for the 34 HFS when you need a straightforward center console platform that also serves the broader role of a motor yacht. Its overall length of 34 ft (10.39 m) and a 10 ft (3.18 m) beam give it stable proportions, and the twin Yamaha outboards (gas) keep propulsion simple and familiar for day trips and active recreational use. The fiberglass and plastic hull combined with a fiberglass deck prioritizes low maintenance, long-term durability, and year-round operation. Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 34 HFS? A: It's a center console motor yacht

manufactured by JUPITER featuring a fiberglass and plastic hull and a fiberglass deck, highlighting **type** , a **center console** configuration, and a durable **hull** construction.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the 34 HFS? A: The vessel measures **LOA** 34 ft (10.39 m) with a **beam** of 10 ft (3.18 m), providing proportioned geometry for steady handling.

Q: What is the draft of the 34 HFS? A: The **draft** spans from a minimum of 6.562 ft (2 m) up to a maximum of 9.843 ft (3 m), giving adaptable draft options across different waters.

Q: What powers the 34 HFS and what fuel does it use? A: Propulsion is supplied by two (**2**) **Yamaha outboard** engines running on **gas** , offering a dependable and easily serviced powerplant.

Q: What onboard capacities and amenities are included? A: Tankage includes **fuel capacity** of 325 gal and **water capacity** of 50 gal, and the layout includes **1 head** for onboard convenience. Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers frequently describe the 34 HFS from JUPITER as an all-purpose 34 foot center console: capable as a tournament dayboat for sportfishing, practical as a family cruiser for sandbar days and weekend runs, useful as a reliable yacht tender, and credited with a hull that many reviewers say is capable of offshore crossings in a wide range of sea states.

On the water, reports commonly praise a smooth, dry ride and the confidence of a deep V hull in chop and head seas. Independent testing has recorded an economical cruise in the neighborhood of ~32–33 kt at about 3,000 rpm, while top speeds reported in reviews reach roughly ~60–64 mph depending on the

installed power. Owners and brokers also note responsive, assured handling at speed. Cabin and deck comfort are well addressed with a stand-up console that includes a head and sink, split forward bow seating that converts to a sun lounge, and a level of fit-and-finish reviewers often describe as "yacht quality" for this size. Serviceability is another plus—wiring and rigging are commonly cited as neatly routed and 12V systems well organized, which simplifies routine maintenance. Reviewers do not identify recurring, model-specific failures beyond typical outboard upkeep. While routine engine service can be significant—especially with triple outboard configurations mentioned in some listings—many newer boats are noted with extended Yamaha Y.E.S. coverage, and owners frequently praise dealer support: "Customer service has been phenomenal. We have never had an issue with the boat but we have reached out several times with a question or two."

Pros and Cons

- Smooth, dry deep V performance offshore with confident control in chop and head seas.
- Highly adaptable platform that suits sportfishing tournaments, family cruising, yacht tender duties, and offshore passages.
- Fit and finish often described as yacht quality, with service friendly wiring, rigging, and console access.
- Triple outboard setups increase routine maintenance obligations and associated costs for owners.
- Warranty and coverage differ between boats; some listings include extended Yamaha Y.E.S. plans.
- Achievable top speeds depend on the power configuration selected, so match performance expectations to the chosen propulsion package.

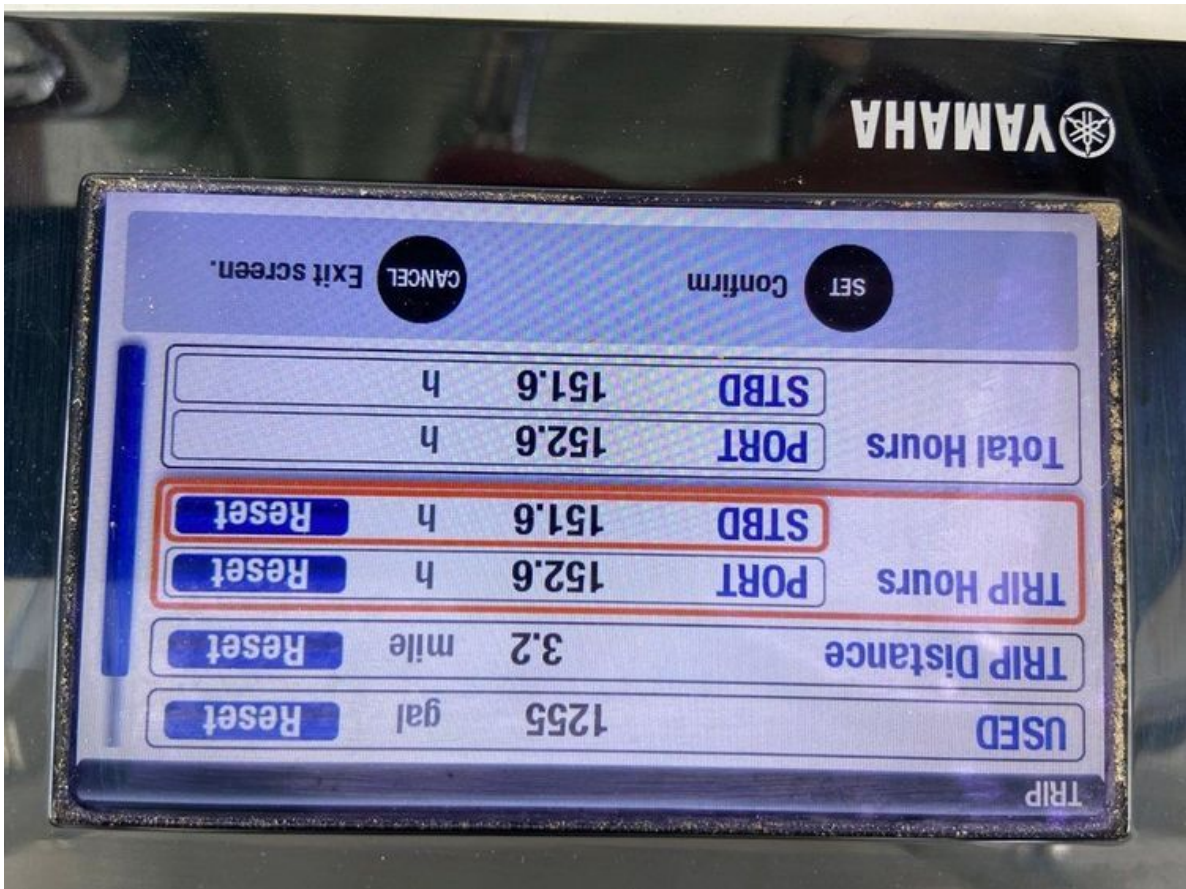
