## OVERVIEW

---

Presented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, the 1720 Center Console from KEY WEST is a compact, capable motor yacht presented in a practical center console arrangement and built with resilient fiberglass construction. Equipped with a single Yamaha outboard, uncomplicated systems, and an efficient footprint, it's an attractive option for owners who prioritize simplicity and utility on a tried-and-true monohull.

## Selecting a 1720 Center Console

---

Deciding on the 1720 Center Console depends on how you intend to use the boat. If you prefer an unadorned layout, complete 360-degree deck mobility, and a vessel that's easy to trailer and stow, this center console model should be high on your list. Note the shallow-to-moderate draft spread (3.281 ft to 6.562 ft) for access to a variety of waterways, the steady 7 ft beam that provides sure footing, and the 40-gallon fuel tank that supports extended day outings. As a compact motor yacht powered by a single outboard, it keeps ownership straightforward while delivering dependable Yamaha performance.

Q: What type of yacht is the 1720 Center Console? A: It's a motor yacht in the center console category featuring a **single outboard** and an **open deck** layout.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: LOA measures **17 ft (5.18 m)** , beam is **7 ft (2.13 m)** , and draft varies from **3.281 ft (1 m)** to **6.562 ft (2 m)** .

Q: What propulsion does it use? A: The vessel is fitted with **1 × Yamaha Outboard** running on **Gas** , offering uncomplicated performance and straightforward servicing.

Q: What materials are used in construction? A: The hull is categorized as fiberglass and plastic with a **Fiberglass** deck designed for longevity and low maintenance.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners commonly pick the 1720 Center Console by KEY WEST for inshore day runs, family outings, and fishing in skinny water. The boat is often praised as a "great hull" and a no-nonsense platform; its factory seating and capacity generally suit small groups of about four. In favorable weather conditions, owners routinely report comfortable nearshore hops in the 8–10 mile range for fishing trips or beach stops.

On the water, the 17-foot V-hull delivers predictable manners and frequently surprises owners with a better-than-expected ability to slice through bay and nearshore chop. The spec sheet notes a 15° deadrise and recommends 70–90 HP; many operators opt for 90–115 HP and still commend the fuel efficiency,

with remarks such as "unbelievable on gas." The practical layout supports fishing with factory-installed livewell, fish boxes, rod holders, and useful under-console storage, though room is limited for larger parties.

Day-to-day ownership is generally simple but requires hands-on attention. Owners mention that console drainage can trap water if the aft drain slots become clogged, and some older examples have shown fuel-odor issues related to tanks or sender seals; common remedies include pressure-testing the tank and inspecting the sender gasket and fuel lines. Buyer and maintenance discussions also emphasize checking engine compression, reviewing lower-unit service history, and inspecting transom and stringers. The factory manual highlights the battery location under the console, bilge pump specifics, and recommends keeping a charger when the boat remains in the water.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Predictable, confidence-inspiring ride for a 17-foot V-hull in bay and nearshore conditions.
- Excellent fuel economy with the recommended 70–90 HP and even with 90–115 HP commonly seen.
- Practical fishing layout with livewell, fish boxes, rod holders, and good under-console storage for the size.
- Limited space and factory capacity best suit small crews of around four.
- Console area can trap water if the rear drain slots clog, requiring periodic cleaning.
- Older boats may present fuel-odor issues and drivetrain wear, so tanks, sender gaskets, lower units, and transom/stringers deserve close inspection.
