Q: What type of boat is the 1720CC? A: It is a motor yacht arranged in a center console yacht configuration, constructed by KEY WEST.

Q: What are the dimensions of the 1720CC? A: The **LOA** measures 17 ft (5.18 m) and the **beam** is 6 ft (2.03 m).

Q: What powers the 1720CC? A: It is driven by a single **Yamaha outboard** running on **gas**, with a **40-gallon** fuel tank.

Q: How many engines does it have? A: The model is fitted with **1 engine** for simple and reliable operation.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and reviewers commonly categorize the 1720CC by KEY WEST as an ideal inshore and bay fishing craft that also serves well for family fishing outings, light sportfishing, and relaxed weekend runs. Historical listings and factory literature span from early 1990s examples to current catalog offerings, and many buyers consider it a trailerable entry boat or a compact second vessel.

On the water, owners and testers report a steady, stable 17' center console that copes with choppy coastal bays better than its size might suggest. Feedback often praises the hull and describes the boat as a “simple, great hull” with predictable handling; with a 90 hp engine some owners have recorded about 39 mph solo, and the 1720CC typically gets onto plane quickly with 90–115 hp, cruising in the high 20s to low 30s mph depending on load.

Comfort is focused on day use: the boat commonly includes bow cushions and aft jump seats, with a cockpit-centric arrangement that incorporates fish boxes and a livewell, and useful console storage often housing the battery. There is no cabin, and a number of owners note that the seat and console height can feel low for taller individuals. Routine ownership tends to center on basic outboard maintenance, but buyers of used boats should inspect hull and gelcoat for wear from beaching or grounding and be aware that older units have sometimes required fuel-tank replacement (e.g., early 1990s boats).

## Pros and Cons

---

- Stable, predictable inshore ride that handles choppy bays reasonably well for a 17' center-console.
- Quick to plane with 90–115 hp, with owners reporting high-20s/low-30s cruise and about 39 mph solo with a 90 hp.

- Practical day-boat layout with bow cushions, aft jump seats, fish boxes, a livewell, and useful console storage.
- No cabin accommodations, so usage is limited to day trips.
- Some owners find the helm/seat ergonomics too low for comfort.
- Used-boat checks should include gelcoat/hull wear from beaching and, on older examples, possible fuel-tank replacement.
