## OVERVIEW

---

The 179FS by KEY WEST is a compact motor yacht built around a flexible center console layout. Listed through Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, it combines uncomplicated handling and single-engine simplicity for confident days on the water.

### Selecting a 179FS

---

Measuring 17 ft (5.18 m) overall with a 7 ft (2.21 m) beam, the 179FS is ideal for owners who prioritize easy trailering, compact storage, and access to a variety of waterways. As a bona fide center console platform, its design emphasizes straightforward ergonomics and versatile deck use.

The model is driven by a single Yamaha gas outboard, a configuration chosen for its low-maintenance operation and simplified ownership. With a 40-gallon fuel tank, the 179FS is capable of supporting a wide range of day-boat activities, though actual range depends on load, sea state, and throttle use.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners tend to use the 179FS from KEY WEST exactly as it's intended: a family-friendly dayboat that doubles as a casual fishing platform. It trailers without fuss, fits in many home garages, and performs well on lakes, rivers, and nearshore coastal trips.

Published Yamaha figures for the F115 place top speed near 46.7 MPH, a plane time of about 4.06 seconds, and roughly 8.85 seconds to reach 30 MPH. These numbers provide a baseline; individual results will vary by load and conditions.

Some owners note the initial hole shot can feel somewhat sluggish until the prop selection and engine trim are optimized; several owners have also added trim tabs, which they report help to settle the bow, cut down on porpoising, and can improve fuel consumption.

Onboard, the center console feels roomy for an 18-foot platform, with ample bow storage, an under-console battery compartment, and a drop-in locker above the bilge; many owners favor the aft-deck layout compared with earlier 176-series arrangements. The factory bimini is praised for its construction and headroom, and the leaning post receives positive comments for comfort, though one owner mentioned a preference for a slightly lower foot rail.

Small details include a battery selector mounted in a spot that isn't

immediately obvious and mixed opinions on the gunwale cushion layout. Serviceability is a strength thanks to the bilge arrangement and recessed battery location, and the owner's manual outlines maintenance with a 10-year structural hull warranty and a 1-year nonstructural warranty; community forums do not indicate any widespread mechanical problems for this model.

## Pros and Cons

- Stable, dry ride that handles 2–3 ft chop well for its size.
- Roomy layout with generous storage and a quality bimini for family day use.
- Trailerable package that fits many garages and tows behind most modern SUVs.
- Hole shot can feel lethargic until prop and trim are dialed in.
- Battery selector placement is not intuitive at first glance.
- Owners often add trim tabs to reduce porpoising and optimize ride and economy.
