OVERVIEW

The KEY WEST 219 FS is a 21-foot motor yacht built as a compact center console class craft. Its hull and deck are molded from fiberglass and it is driven by a single Yamaha gasoline outboard. Listed by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, the design delivers a simple, uncluttered platform in a small, capable package.

Selecting a 219 FS

It's well suited to buyers looking for a center console layout under 22 feet within the larger motor yacht segment. With an 80-gallon fuel tank, it offers extended range that reduces the need for frequent refueling during day trips.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly choose the 219 FS from KEY WEST because it easily flips between family days and light-tackle fishing. Bow and aft cushions with removable backrests convert swiftly to create comfortable seating for both kids and adults on short cruises, then the forward and cockpit spaces open up for casting. The shallow 1'2" draft makes it simple to access flats and sandbars, and the removable ski pylon plus swim ladder are popular for tow-sport activities. With coaming bolsters, rodholders, and a transom livewell, 3-4 anglers can operate effectively. One owner summed it up succinctly: "Love my 219fs".

On the water, owners and evaluators report a surprisingly composed ride for a 21-footer in choppy conditions; the stepped 19/24° deadrise helps the hull cut through waves without harsh impacts. Real-world, fully loaded cruises typically land in the upper 30s mph with top speeds reaching the mid-40s using mid-range Yamaha power, and the boat accelerates quickly from a stop—one long-term tester described the hole-shot as "neck-snapping." Multiple owners note that engine and prop choices materially affect either hole-shot or top-end speed. Early examples experienced some charging/stator or grounding faults and occasional trim-tab wiring shorts; dealers resolved many of these items under warranty. Aft lockers have a tendency to retain water, so some owners installed drains to direct it to the bilge. Routine maintenance is straightforward with a single outboard, though the responsiveness and quality of dealer service vary by area.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile family-to-fishing layout with quick-convert bow and aft seating.
- Smooth ride for its size with quick hole-shot and brisk midrange performance.

- Shallow draft and nearshore range fit bays, sandbars, and light-tackle trips up to ~20 miles offshore.
- Limited bulk storage and a compact console head constrain comfort on longer outings.
- Reports of electrical/charging and trim-tab wiring issues on some early examples, often addressed by dealers.
- Aft lockers can trap water, and some owners add drains to route it to the bilge.
