## OVERVIEW

---

Meet the 239 DFS from KEY WEST—a compact, capable motor yacht built on a sturdy fiberglass hull and configured for efficient day use with a single Honda outboard. Offered through Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales.

### Selecting a 239 DFS

---

If you prioritize a modest footprint (LOA 24 ft / 7.32 m; beam 8 ft / 2.62 m) paired with sensible onboard systems (1 head, 13 gal water, 100 gal fuel), the 239 DFS represents a practical, easy-to-manage option.

Boasting a cruising speed of 22 knots (25.32 mph) and a draft that spans 4.593 ft (1.4 m) to 7.546 ft (2.3 m), it delivers reliable transit performance while preserving access to a wide variety of waterways.

As a motor yacht produced by KEY WEST, it appeals to owners who want straightforward operation and low maintenance fiberglass construction.

### Features of the Model

---

- Propulsion efficiency: single Honda outboard (gas) for simple operation and accessible servicing.
- Confident ride: monohull configuration that promotes predictable tracking and steady stability.
- Construction: fiberglass deck atop a durable fiberglass/plastic hull for lasting strength.
- Cruise performance: capable of 22 knots (25.32 mph) for relaxed day passages.
- Practical amenities: one head, 100 gal fuel capacity and 13 gal fresh water for full-day outings.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What is the **cruising speed** of the 239 DFS? A: The vessel cruises at approximately 22 knots (25.32 mph), a practical speed for comfortable day trips and efficient transit.

Q: What **engine** and **fuel type** power the boat? A: It is equipped with a single Honda **outboard** running on **gas**, a simple arrangement that eases maintenance and serviceability.

Q: What are the key **dimensions** and **draft**? A: The **LOA** measures 24 ft (7.32 m), the **beam** is 8 ft (2.62 m), and the **draft** varies between 4.593 ft (1.4 m) and 7.546 ft (2.3 m).

Q: What onboard **capacities** and amenities does it include? A: The craft carries 100 gal of fuel, 13 gal of fresh water, and is fitted with 1 **head** for convenience.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Buyers commonly select the 239 DFS from KEY WEST for family-oriented day cruising and short weekend escapes; many owners praise it as a solid value proposition. It's frequently trailered to launch ramps or berthed in marinas, with a high concentration in Florida waters. The dual-console arrangement receives positive notes for family comfort—bow cushions and back to back lounging are highlighted—though some owners observe that stern cushions slightly diminish transom fishability compared with older dual-console designs. Regular use includes inshore/ICW passages and nearshore fishing.

On the water, owners describe the ride as surprisingly dry and soft given the size, noting the hull feels very solid underway. One owner on Lake Erie reported running in approximately 3' seas with only modest spray. Several owners suggest installing a higher-rated outboard—around 250 hp—to gain stronger performance margins and additional reserve. Complaints of bow-pitching or listing have often been traced to uneven load distribution rather than inherent design problems.

Daily ownership notes center on routine pump and system maintenance. Examples include replacing a freshwater washdown pump and addressing the typical failures of macerator or raw-water pumps; some owners reposition components to improve priming reliability. The quick-start guide indicates the fuel/water separator is located in the bilge and can be accessed through the engine-pod hatch. A minority of purchasers encountered dealer prep or QC issues—corroded stereos, faulty gauges, or unprimed pumps—which were subsequently remedied by dealers or owners.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Dry, soft ride for the class with an exceptionally solid hull, according to multiple owner reports.
- Family-oriented dual-console layout with bow cushions and back-to-back seating, plus notable storage capacity for its size.
- Flexible platform for ICW/nearshore fishing, family day cruises, and trailerable weekend outings; commonly found in Florida marinas.
- Stern cushions reduce transom fishability compared with older dual-console arrangements, as noted by some owners.
- Many owners recommend fitting at least 250 hp to achieve stronger performance and reserve power.
- Reported issues with pumps and dealer prep/QC (washdown, macerator, stereo/gauges) may require owner or dealer attention.
