## OVERVIEW

---

The 239 FS from KEY WEST is a multipurpose center console platform categorized in the motor yacht class. The design uses durable fiberglass and plastic construction and is offered through Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

## Selecting a 239 FS

---

If your brief calls for a manageable 24-foot center console with the simplicity of single engine operation, the 239 FS fits that description. With a 24 ft (7.32 m) LOA, an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam, a lone Honda outboard, and a 100 gallon fuel tank, it's well suited for day trips and coastal outings. ## Features of the Model

---

- 24 ft (7.32 m) overall length provides a compact, easy handled platform on the water.
- 8 ft (2.59 m) beam gives a roomy deck layout while remaining trailer friendly.
- Equipped with a single Honda outboard—straightforward to operate and economical to maintain.
- Gasoline propulsion supported by a 100 gallon fuel tank for extended daytime runs.
- Built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic construction hull with a fiberglass deck for dependable performance.
- The center console platform layout offers flexible deck arrangements for cruising, angling, and family activities.

## Questions and Answers

---

- Q: What is the **category** of the 239 FS? A: The boat is a center console yacht that sits within the broader motor yachts class, constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull.
- Q: Who is the **builder** of this model? A: The 239 FS is manufactured by KEY WEST, with representation by Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team.
- Q: What are the **LOA** and **beam** ? A: The vessel measures 24 ft (7.32 m) LOA with an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam.
- Q: What **engine** powers the boat and what is the **fuel type** ? A: Propulsion is

provided by a single Honda **Outboard** , running on **Gas** .

• Q: What is the **fuel capacity** , and what are the **hull and deck** materials? A: Fuel capacity is 100 gal; the hull is fiberglass and plastic and the deck is fiberglass.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners typically employ the 239 FS from KEY WEST as a family oriented dayboat for tubing, quick beach runs, and relaxed weekend cruising. Many operators use it as a crossover—part family boat, part casual fishing platform—and the choice of leaning post is frequently discussed: the convenience center option (sink/cooler) is appreciated for family outings but can encroach on the aft deck, and owners report the step design can make removing a half filled cooler difficult.

Power selection is a common conversation point among owners. Forum opinion typically recommends a minimum of 250 hp, with several owners who specified 250 hp later wishing they had chosen 300 hp for extra reserve. The boat can feel wet in certain sea states. Rental and charter operations sometimes outfit the 239 FS with 200 hp, though private buyers often opt for more horsepower. Boats fitted with Seakeeper Ride have shown noticeable stability improvements: a 2023 239 FS equipped with a Yamaha 250 hp reported approximately 35% reduction in roll and 54% reduction in pitch at 26 mph in 1 ft seas during a sea trial.

Several owners report delivery and fit and finish shortcomings—examples include tangled wiring, improperly seated screws, and incomplete paperwork—plus at least one incidence of a severely imbalanced propeller causing pronounced vibration. Smaller component failures also appear in owner feedback, such as freshwater washdown pumps that failed after a couple of years. Owners additionally warn about proper engine break in

procedures, citing a dealer example where a new Yamaha was revved above 4,000 rpm on its first outing.

## Pros and Cons

- Versatile platform for family cruising, tubing, beach runs, and casual fishing.
- The ski pole functions as a practical handhold and boarding assist while staying out of the way for anglers.
- Sea trial data with Seakeeper Ride on a 2023 model indicated about 35% roll and 54% pitch reduction at 26 mph in 1 ft seas.
- Many owners recommend 250 hp as a baseline, with some wishing they had chosen 300 hp for extra performance.
- The boat can produce a wet ride depending on sea conditions.
- Multiple owner reports of delivery and fit and finish issues, including messy wiring, prop imbalance, and missing paperwork.
