OVERVIEW

Purpose-built for demanding offshore runs yet equally suited to relaxed family outings, the 291FS by KEY WEST is a multi-purpose center console layout that sits squarely in the broader motor yacht segment. Represented by Andrey Shestakov and the Shestakov Yacht Sales team, this model delivers usable performance and straightforward systems owners value.

Selecting a 291FS

Pick the 291FS if you want a manageable size that still offers generous deck real estate: a 29 ft (8.84 m) LOA paired with a 9 ft (2.9 m) beam provides stable handling and ample working and entertaining space without creating storage headaches. Propulsion comes from twin Yamaha outboards running on gasoline for lively throttle response, and the single head adds practical convenience for extended days afloat. As a contemporary center-console platform in the motor yacht category, the 291FS is well suited to anglers, weekend cruisers, and families seeking one versatile boat.

Questions and Answers

Q: What are the dimensions of the 291FS? A: The **LOA** is 29 ft (8.84 m) and the **beam** is 9 ft (2.9 m).

Q: What engines power the boat? A: It features **2 Yamaha Outboard** engines operating on **Gas** .

Q: How much fuel does it carry? A: The **fuel capacity** is 200 gallons.

Q: Is there a head onboard? A: Yes—there is **1 head** for added comfort during longer outings.

Q: What type of yacht is it? A: It's a center-console design within the motor yacht class.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly describe the 291FS from KEY WEST as a true dual purpose 29-foot center console: capable of serious offshore or day fishing midweek while serving as a comfortable family cruiser on weekends. The usable deck—often cited around 29'1" LOA and 9'8" beam in owner posts—supports both fishing setups and social outings, and discussion threads frequently cover practical upgrades like rod storage solutions, the fish door, and common trolling-motor installs. A November 2023 Seakeeper sea-trial recorded approximately 50% reduction in roll and 63% reduction in pitch at 30 mph in 2–4 ft seas, showing that motion-control additions can noticeably smooth the ride for coastal and light offshore conditions.

On the water, owners caution that the 291FS can take a spray in true head seas—one forum post warned “any head sea over 1.5' and you are getting wet.” Operators often recommend running tabs and using engine trim to settle the bow, and many report cruising comfortably around 28–30 mph with twin 300s when sea state permits. Inside the console, comments call for additional storage and vertical rod racks, and a number of owners have expressed interest in glass enclosure or console-leg options. Bow and anchor-locker access and structure are common retrofit topics; one owner fitting a trolling motor noted that “shuttle slides flex like crazy” and necessitated a backing plate. Maintenance chatter centers on regular Yamaha outboard servicing and upkeep of trim/tabs, and across the threads we reviewed there were no recurring reports of major hull or system failures.

Pros and Cons

- The 29'1" LOA and 9'8" beam provide a roomy deck for mixed family cruising and offshore/day fishing use.
- Sea-trial data shows a Seakeeper system reduced roll by about 50% and pitch by 63% at 30 mph in 2–4 ft seas.
- Practical fishing features are supported by rod storage, a fish door, and common trolling motor installs.
- Several owners report a wet ride in head seas over roughly 1.5 feet.
- Best ride results require active trim tab and engine trim management to keep the bow down.
- Owners ask for more console and upright rod storage, and some bow/anchor locker retrofits demand backing plates and careful access.
