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OVERVIEW

The KS88 from KINGSHIP MARINE is an 87 ft (26.7 m) passage motor yacht in the motor yachts class conceived by Barracuda Yacht Design. It is built around a sturdy aluminum hull with aluminum decks in a Monohull arrangement, offering a 25 ft (7.7 m) beam, a 5.413 ft (1.65 m) draft, and economical performance—typically 11 kn cruising and up to 13 kn top speed. Select the KS88 if you prioritise rugged metal construction combined with practical cruising range in a refined motor yacht. Its 25 ft (7.7 m) beam delivers generous interior volume and comfort, while the shallow 5.413 ft (1.65 m) draft opens up more anchorages and cruising areas. Twin Volvo Penta propulsion provides dependable performance and an efficient 11 kn cruise. With sleeping arrangements for up to 10 and thoughtfully sized tanks, the design suits extended family voyages or a charter-style guest program — facilitated by Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov.

Q: What type of yacht is the KS88? A: It is a **motor yacht** within the **motor yachts class**, featuring an **aluminum hull** arranged as a **Monohull**, and it was penned by Barracuda Yacht Design.

Q: How fast does it go? A: The KS88 is typically operated at a **cruising speed of 11 kn (12.66 mph)** and can reach a **maximum speed of 13 kn (14.96 mph)** for passage-making.

Q: How many people can stay on board and what are the key capacities? A: The yacht accommodates **10** persons. Significant tankage figures are **fuel 2377.55 gal** and **fresh water 792.52 gal**, designed to support prolonged trips.

Owner Experience Review

KS88 from KINGSHIP MARINE is marketed as a long range displacement cruiser suitable for private or family use, with published cruising ranges quoted in the vicinity of 2,000 to 3,200 nautical miles and sleeping arrangements configured for 8–10 guests. Broker briefs highlight that the layout is manageable with a small crew or by an experienced owner operator couple, and that guest arrangements can be adapted for charter operations.

On the water, its displacement monohull profile produces a working cruise band of roughly 10–12 knots and a quoted top speed near 14 knots.

Promotional material describes it as “one of the most stable yachts in class,” though independent owner sea trial reports or third party handling reviews for the KS88 have not yet become widely available, given the model’s introduction around 2024–2025.

Arrangement plans show full beam master and full beam VIP suites, each with multiple en suites, while the galley, wheelhouse, and crew mess are located on the main deck to support owner/guest and crew separation. Construction is specified as all aluminium and the propulsion package is twin 425 hp Volvo units; there are no public forum accounts of model specific engine failures, but likewise no owner sourced long term maintenance cost or liveability/ergonomic studies have been published to date. As a result, current assessments rely mainly on manufacturer and broker specifications until broader in service feedback emerges.

Pros and Cons

- Long range capability (about 2,000–3,200 nm) with accommodation for 8–10 guests.
- Advertised as manageable by a small crew or an experienced owner operator couple.
- Guest layouts include full beam master and full beam VIP cabins with multiple en suites, and are presented as charter capable.
- No independent owner sea trial or handling reviews are publicly available for KS88 yet.
- Public owner forums have not produced substantive liveability or ergonomic feedback for this model.
- Long term maintenance cost and reliability data have not been reported by owners because of the yacht’s limited in service history.

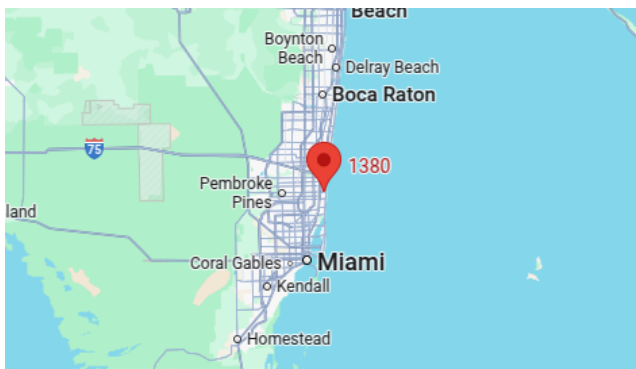
