OVERVIEW

The Sixty 5 from LAGOON CATAMARANS is a 67 ft sail yacht catamaran constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull, a GRP deck, and an interior package by NAUTA DESIGN. This listing is presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov.

Selecting a Sixty 5

Measuring 67 ft (20.55 m) overall with a broad 32 ft (10 m) beam and a shallow 5.085 ft (1.55 m) draft, the Sixty 5 offers substantial interior volume while allowing access to many coastal cruising areas. Twin Yanmar inboard diesel engines provide an economical 10 kn cruise and a top speed near 12.6 kn (11.51 / 14.5 mph). The layout supports up to 12 guests and includes 5 heads, making it well suited to extended voyages. As a catamaran within the sail yacht category, it prioritizes stability and livable space—important considerations for many purchasers. Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the Sixty 5? A: It is a sail yacht catamaran built with a fiberglass and plastic hull. The twin hull arrangement is designed to maximize stability and living area for **family cruising** and **long stays** aboard.

Q: Who builds the Sixty 5 and who designed the interior? A: The vessel is produced by LAGOON CATAMARANS, with interior styling and layout by **NAUTA DESIGN**. This collaboration aims to combine **functional ergonomics** with **refined finishes**.

Q: How fast does the Sixty 5 go? A: The vessel cruises at approximately 10 kn (11.51 mph) and reaches a **top speed** near 12.6 kn (14.5 mph), driven by twin Yanmar inboard diesel engines.

Q: How many people can stay aboard and how many heads are there? A: The Sixty 5 accommodates up to 12 guests and is fitted with **5 heads**, providing privacy and comfort for larger parties.

Owner Experience Review

Owners frequently choose the Sixty 5 from LAGOON CATAMARANS for extended cruising and liveaboard purposes, attracted by multiple layout options ranging from four to six cabins. Configurations include up to six doubles or a 5 cabin arrangement focused on an owner suite. Many owners opt to employ a captain, chef and mate accommodated in dedicated crew quarters, and some offset owning expenses by chartering with full crew for

roughly 5–10 weeks annually.

When sailing, feedback highlights the yacht's emphasis on comfort and steady handling rather than outright speed. One test recorded about 5 knots under a Code 0 in a mere 7 knots of wind, while delivery and broker records indicate comfortable cruising above 10 knots and 12+ knots with a Code 0 in approximately 19–20 knots of breeze. The flybridge helm, supplementary helm stations and the topside galley enhance sightlines and guest interaction, and owners often praise the generous interior—approximately 90 m²—with particularly luxurious owner staterooms.

From a maintenance perspective, listings and brochures often point out stand up engine room access and accessible inspection hatches. The Sixty 5 commonly comes equipped with twin Yanmar diesels (150–195 hp choices) and twin generator sets. Owners note that the extensive hotel systems (air conditioning, gensets and other systems) increase routine service scope and spare parts expenses. Online owner forums have documented isolated quality control issues on some LAGOON CATAMARANS production models (including earlier bulkhead concerns on the 450 series), occasional reports of window bonding failures, and challenging after sales interactions; a comprehensive structural survey prior to purchase is strongly recommended.

Pros and Cons

- Vast interior volume (about 90 m²) and adaptable 4–6 cabin plans, with crew oriented spaces suitable for private ownership or charter operations.
- Smooth, stable passages with reported cruising speeds in the 10+ knot range and 12+ knots under Code 0 in roughly 19–20 knots of wind.
- Flybridge helm, multiple helm positions and a topside galley improve visibility and social flow, complemented by notably sumptuous owner staterooms.
- Not optimized for high upwind performance; design priorities favor comfort

over race level metrics.

- Community feedback has cited build quality concerns and after sales service issues on some LAGOON CATAMARANS models, so a full pre purchase survey is advisable.
- A large systems footprint (twin gensets, air conditioning and multiple hotel systems) tends to increase routine maintenance complexity and parts costs.

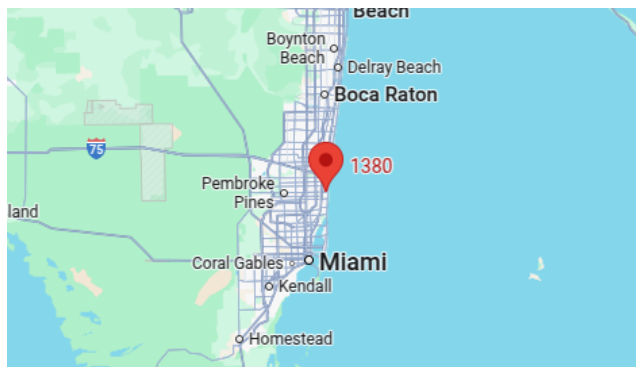
