Measuring 45 ft (13.72 m) overall, fitted with a fiberglass deck and powered by a single Yanmar engine, it's an appealing choice for cruising. Q1: What kind of yacht is the 450F? A1: It is a sail yacht catamaran constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull, offering the sailing characteristics of a yacht together with multihull comfort.

Q2: What are the dimensions of the model? A2: The vessel's **LOA** is **45 ft (13.72 m)**, a size that fits a wide range of marinas and suits varied cruising plans.

Q3: What powers the yacht under engine? A3: The 450F is fitted with **1 × Yanmar** engine, delivering reliable auxiliary power and easy maintenance routines.

Q4: What materials are used for hull and deck? A4: The hull is listed as

fiberglass and plastic, while the deck is finished in **fiberglass**, chosen for durability and simpler upkeep.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the 450F from Lagoon as a versatile family or liveaboard cruising platform and as a reliable charter vessel. Private owners tend to favor the Owner's Version for extended coastal or blue water passages, while 4 cabin configurations are common in charter operations and for Mediterranean weekenders because of their spaciousness, social layout, and guest-friendly design.

The saloon and sleeping areas are frequently praised for their roominess, featuring large vertical coachroof windows and generous headroom; the flybridge serves both as an excellent helm station and a comfortable lounging area with broad visibility. The U shaped galley is functional underway, although some owners modify sink and freezer layouts, and a few report limited freezer volume as an operational constraint.

Sailing performance is typically strongest on a reach or beam reach, with dependable downwind behavior and respectable speeds; upwind pointing is more conservative, and heavy loading reduces performance. Owners describe generally stable, forgiving motion for passengers, with occasional hobby horsing in short chop and an overall feel that's less sporty than high performance cats. Under power, sea trials commonly report just under 8 knots in calm conditions at roughly 2,900 rpm. One owner summarized their experience: "Have had her in 40 knots true, downwind, with only a small amount of jib out, and we were super comfortable."

Owners do undertake offshore passages with the 450F, though most recommend thorough preparation and inspections beforehand. Reported maintenance concerns include forward mast/bulkhead deformation on certain boats—Lagoon has implemented an inspection and repair program—and such repairs can be substantial, with “bulkhead work done” commonly noted in listings. Boats built before September 2018 should be checked for the Goiot escape hatch recall, and routine saildrive servicing (seals and diaphragms) is often advised; confirming service records is a sensible precaution.

Pros and Cons

- Expansive saloon and cabins with large coachroof windows and ample headroom make it well suited to family liveaboard cruising.
- Flybridge provides excellent helm visibility and a sociable lounging area.
- Stable, guest friendly motion with comfortable downwind and reaching characteristics and approximately 8 knots at 2,900 rpm in smooth water.
- Limited upwind pointing and reduced performance when the boat is heavily loaded.
- Documented forward mast/bulkhead issues necessitate inspection and, on some yachts, reinforcement repairs.
- Goiot escape hatches fitted before Sept 2018 are subject to recall and should be verified or replaced.
