The Lagoon 39' 2015 by Lagoon is a versatile motor yacht-style catamaran built in durable fiberglass construction. It pairs twin diesel propulsion with practical onboard comforts and systems designed for comfortable cruising. This listing is presented by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

### Selecting a Lagoon 39' 2015

---

If you prioritize the room and seaworthiness of a catamaran, the dependable push of twin **Yanmar diesel** powerplants, and the convenience of **2 heads** with generous **fuel** and **water** reserves, the Lagoon 39' 2015 is a logical choice. Its wide 22 ft (6.81 m) beam increases living and deck volume, while a fiberglass construction hull and fiberglass deck reduce maintenance demands. ## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What are the key dimensions of the Lagoon 39' 2015? A: The vessel measures an **LOA** of 39 ft (11.89 m) and carries a **beam** of 22 ft (6.81 m), delivering notable interior and deck volume for a catamaran.

Q: What powers this motor yacht? A: Propulsion comes from a pair of **engines** manufactured by **Yanmar** , running on **diesel** , providing reliable drive for this catamaran.

Q: What is the draft? A: The maximum **draft** is 13.123 ft (4 m).

Q: What are the fuel and water capacities? A: **Fuel capacity** is 106 gal and

**water capacity** is 79 gal, allowing for extended periods between fills.

Q: What is the hull made of, and who can assist with purchase? A: The hull is constructed of fiberglass construction with a fiberglass deck. For purchase assistance, contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales for comprehensive brokerage services.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and reviewers have used the Lagoon 39' 2015 as a family cruiser, a weekend sociable boat, and as part of charter operations. The roomy cockpit and light-filled saloon with tall vertical windows contribute to comfortable living aboard, while 2–4 cabin arrangements — including mirror image aft cabins — offer privacy and flexible accommodation options for couples or small crews.

Under sail, published tests of the Lagoon platform recorded a steady 6–7 knots close hauled in approximately 18–22 knots of wind, with no pounding and a reasonably dry ride; on a reach off the wind, speeds over 8 knots were attainable in favorable conditions. An owner's passage account highlighted the model's composed behavior in ocean swell and cross seas as comfortable and secure. That said, in light airs the boat can feel sluggish unless equipped with an overlapping genoa or a specific downwind sail.

Feedback on maintenance and systems is varied. Reviewers have complimented well-labeled wiring and plumbing and easy access to engines; one transatlantic owner estimated roughly 2.5 L/hr per engine for extended motoring, and paired with 600 W of solar and a watermaker this delivered strong at-anchor autonomy. Conversely, owner forums note structural or bulkhead issues on some production boats that have required significant repairs, and those reports have deterred at least one potential buyer from proceeding.

## Pros and Cons

- Family- and charter-friendly layout with 2–4 cabin choices, a capacious cockpit, and a luminous saloon with tall vertical windows.
- Demonstrated upwind speed of 6–7 knots in roughly 18–22 knots of breeze with a fairly dry, non-pounding motion.
- Excellent potential for self-sufficiency noted in an owner report using 600 W of solar combined with a watermaker at anchor.
- Underperformance in light winds unless fitted with an overlapping genoa or a dedicated downwind sail.
- Community reports of structural/bulkhead issues on certain boats, with repairs that can be extensive when required.
- Such service and structural reports have caused some buyers to hesitate before purchasing.

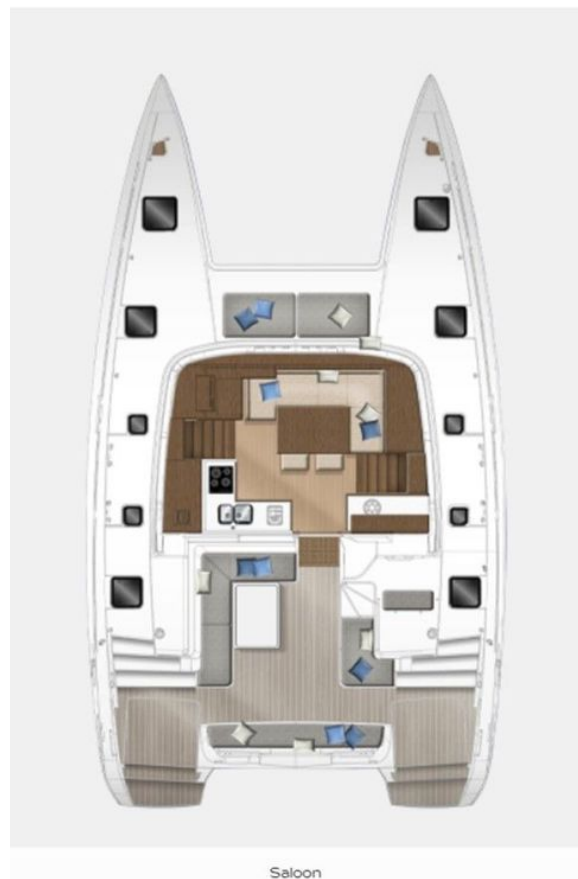
