Opting for the Lagoon 52 means choosing a highly adaptable sailing yacht that performs well as a comfortable catamaran. Its 52 ft (15.84 m) LOA combined with a generous 28 ft (8.6 m) beam provide abundant living volume and steady behavior at sea, while twin inboard Yanmar diesels make close-quarters handling straightforward. Configured for up to 10 guests with five heads and separate crew quarters, it is equally suited to private family cruising or a charter business. - **Twin-engine maneuverability:** Two inboard Yanmar diesel engines offer confident handling in marinas and provide redundancy for added safety
- **Catamaran stability:** A wide 28 ft (8.6 m) beam and the catamaran hull form deliver excellent stability and generous interior volume
- **Practical capacities:** 253.6 gal fresh water and 131.03 gal fuel capacity support extended cruising and autonomy offshore
- **Comfortable accommodations:** Arranged to sleep up to 10 guests, with 5 heads and separate crew quarters providing 2 beds for professional crews
- **Durable construction:** Built with a fiberglass and plastic hull and finished with a composite deck for longevity and lower maintenance

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the Lagoon 52? A: It is a **sailing** yacht configured as a **twin-hull** catamaran constructed with **durable** fiberglass construction.

Q: Who is the builder of the Lagoon 52? A: The vessel is built by **Lagoon**, a yard recognized for producing innovative **catamarans** and premium **sailing yachts**.

Q: How many people can the Lagoon 52 accommodate? A: The layout accommodates **up to 10** guests, includes **5 heads**, and features **2 crew cabins** with **2 beds** to house professional crew.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the Lagoon 52? A: The **LOA** is 52 ft (15.84 m) and the **beam** measures 28 ft (8.6 m), providing ample internal volume and generous deck areas.

Q: What powers the Lagoon 52? A: Propulsion comes from two **inboard Yanmar diesel** engines, giving dependable thrust and easy **maneuvering** alongside the catamaran layout.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly report using the Lagoon 52 for family passages with reduced crew and for extended multi-month voyages, as well as in charter operations with professional crews. It has handled offshore passages, including transatlantic deliveries, and owners have recorded 200+ mile days when weather and routing align. Under power the boat is often described as very comfortable; under sail some skippers mention keeping it “in the groove” requires attention because helm feel can be less precise; in lighter conditions many improve performance by adding a Code 0, a square-top mainsail, or a VMG-focused sail inventory.

Aboard, the emphasis on volume and comfort is immediately evident in the Lagoon design language: the owner’s suite is frequently compared to a high-end hotel cabin, and the airy saloon with large coachroof glazing opens directly into the cockpit in a flybridge-oriented deck plan. The galley receives

strong accolades—reviewers often call it among the best afloat—with generous storage and on many boats a household-sized fridge/freezer installed in the hull to support extended provisioning.

On the ownership front, new buyers typically work through a snagging list after handover, and several owners advise monitoring bonded windows and escape hatches, often recommending re-bedding or replacement where leaks or fit issues appear. Routine servicing is generally made easier by accessible systems and engine bays, though sail handling can be complicated by limited access to the mainsail and a few ergonomic compromises that some owners address with modest upgrades.

Pros and Cons

- Pro: The Lagoon 52 is relaxing under power for long motoring stretches.
- Pro: Livability stands out with an upscale-feeling owner's cabin, bright saloon, and a galley praised as one of the best.
- Pro: Good access to systems and engines eases routine service and ownership.
- Con: Helm response can feel vague, making it harder to keep the boat in the groove at optimal angles.
- Con: Light-air performance is only moderate unless equipped with a Code 0, square-top main, or VMG package.
- Con: Owners report issues with bonded windows and escape hatches, with some advising re-bedding or replacement.
