OVERVIEW

The 25 Open from LAKE & BAY is a compact, multipurpose motor yacht built on a robust fiberglass and plastic hull and driven by a single Mercury gas outboard. Offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales, this model pairs manageable dimensions with economical propulsion to deliver confident day trips and reliable inshore performance.

Selecting a 25 Open

Opting for the 25 Open is sensible when you want uncomplicated, dependable performance without a large footprint. Measuring 24 ft (7.32 m) LOA with an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam and a 3.554 ft (1.0833 m) draft, it strikes a balance between stability and access to shallower water. An 80-gallon fuel tank gives you range for longer days afloat with the advantage of a single Mercury outboard. Q: What type of boat is the 25 Open? A: It's a motor yacht produced by LAKE & BAY, configured around a single **outboard** power plant and an intentionally open deck layout.

Q: What engine does it use? A: The model is fitted with a **single** Mercury **outboard** that runs on **gas**, providing straightforward maintenance and broad serviceability.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The **LOA** measures 24 ft (7.32 m), the

beam is 8 ft (2.59 m), and the maximum **draft** is 3.554 ft (1.0833 m).

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: The hull is classified as fiberglass and plastic, while the deck uses **fiberglass** for resilience and low upkeep.

Owner Experience Review

Public feedback from owners on the 25 Open is limited, as the model debuted in 2024; most of the information currently available originates from dealer and broker materials. Those listings indicate owners commonly equip the boat for nearshore and bay fishing with accessories such as power-poles, a Frigid Rigid coffin box/cooler, and a leaning-post livewell. One 2024 listing mentioned the seller upgrading to a larger craft to match expanding fishing needs.

Dedicated, independent sea-trial reports for the 25 Open were not located. Builder literature from LAKE & BAY references a modified-V hull and an 8'6" beam intended to provide stability in bay and nearshore environments, while owners of related Boca Grande models describe brisk acceleration and confident handling once engine/prop combinations and jackplate settings are optimized.

Manufacturer spec sheets and broker brochures emphasize a roomy cockpit, configurable consoles, Sea Dek in the gunnels, insulated wells and Frigid Rigid cooler options, along with substantial in-deck storage; nevertheless, long-term assessments of ergonomics and livability for this specific model have not yet appeared in public forums. No pattern of mechanical failures has been identified so far, and discussion around other Lake & Bay models suggests routine outboard maintenance plus careful prop selection and jackplate

adjustments are important. Prospective buyers should verify local dealer support and whether any warranty is transferable (a 2024 listing did note a transferable warranty).

Pros and Cons

- Fishing-oriented setups such as power-poles, a Frigid Rigid coffin box/cooler, and a leaning-post livewell make the boat well-suited to nearshore and bay fishing.
- The builder specifies a modified-V hull and an 8'6" beam to enhance stability for bay and nearshore conditions.
- A generous cockpit, multiple console options, Sea Dek in the gunnels, insulated wells, and plentiful in-deck storage favor practical day-boat use.
- Independent sea-trials and extended owner feedback specific to the 25 Open are limited given its 2024 introduction.
- Optimal performance can depend on choosing the right prop and fine-tuning the jackplate, as noted by owners of related LAKE & BAY models.
- Buyers should confirm local dealer network and warranty transfer details, since most public information currently comes from sales listings.
