OVERVIEW

The 42' Liberty Custom Flybridge Sportfish from LIBERTY YACHTS is a purpose-built, high-performance flybridge sportfisher designed for serious anglers. Built on a fiberglass and plastic planing hull, this motor yacht blends aggressive speed and offshore capability with layout choices that support crewed operation. Represented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, it offers strong passage-making ability, ample range for full days of fishing, and functional accommodations optimized for working the water.

Selecting a 42' Liberty Custom Flybridge Sportfish

If your priority is a swift, bluewater-capable flybridge sportfish, the 42' Liberty Custom Flybridge Sportfish is an excellent contender. Its twin inboard diesels, planing hull form, and expansive 14 ft beam establish a stable fishing platform and enable prompt offshore transits. Practical tankage and a crew-friendly layout make it equally effective for single-day battle-focused outings or short overnight trips with a professional setup.

Select this Liberty when you want a model that sustains a 32-knot cruise, reaches about 38 knots at full throttle, and benefits from the durability and service network of MAN inboard diesels. With berthing for four, sleeping for two, one head, and a separate crew cabin, the design is concentrated on delivering straightforward sportfishing performance and brisk cruising capabilities.

Features of the Model

- Planing hull built with fiberglass and plastic materials; deck finished in

fiberglass for long term durability and straightforward maintenance.

- Twin MAN inboard diesel powerplants (2) rated to support a 32 kn cruising speed and a 38 kn maximum.
- Generous 600 gallon fuel capacity and 50 gallons of fresh water to sustain extended fishing excursions.
- Layout supports 4 on board, sleeps 2, with 1 head; includes a dedicated crew cabin and single crew berth for professional operations.
- Overall length of 42 ft and a 14 ft beam create a stable, confident footprint; gross tonnage recorded at 20.
- A motor yacht purposefully configured for the sportfisherman market.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 42' Liberty Custom Flybridge Sportfish? A: It's a motor yacht configured specifically for the sportfisherman role, set on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a **Planing** arrangement.

Q: Who is the builder of this model? A: **Builder** : LIBERTY YACHTS. The 42' Liberty Custom Flybridge Sportfish combines customized sportfisher architecture with the reliability of MAN inboard diesel power.

Q: How fast does it cruise and what is the top speed? A: **Cruise speed** is 32 kn (36.83 mph) and **Max speed** is 38 kn (43.73 mph), driven by twin MAN inboard diesel engines.

Q: What are the principal dimensions and draft? A: **LOA** : 42 ft (12.8 m); **Beam** : 14 ft (4.52 m); **Draft** : 12.303 ft (3.75 m).

Q: How many people can stay aboard and what are the crew facilities? A: **Accommodation** count is 4 with **Sleeps** for 2 and **Heads** : 1. **Crew** provision includes 1 crew cabin with 1 bed.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and brokers commonly operate the 42' Liberty Custom Flybridge

Sportfish from LIBERTY YACHTS on demanding offshore ground for bluewater angling, while many also use the design comfortably for family cruising and weekend coastal passages. Market examples listing build years such as 2001, 2003, and 2009 provide useful reference points for buyers comparing inventory.

Underway, the deep V hull—reportedly near 21° deadrise—earns praise for predictable tracking through waves. Sea trials have shown an economical cruise near ~30 knots at about 1,895 rpm and a top-end test approaching 39.5 knots, with steering sharp enough to complete a 180° turn in roughly four boat lengths—handy when working fish or rapidly repositioning.

Inside, accommodations include a forward queen berth, a dinette that converts to additional sleeping space, and a single head with a separate shower, creating a compact but functional cabin for overnight stays. Listings often highlight premium galley equipment (Sub Zero/U Line) and extensive under seat and sole storage. Engine-room access is praised thanks to a large hatch and generous headroom; however, servicing the dripless stuffing boxes can be complicated, sometimes requiring removal of an exhaust manifold because of the oversized fishboxes. Prospective buyers should note that several older hulls have undergone major refits—one example cited a refit cost of approximately \$700,000—and that the model is occasionally referred to as a 39 footer despite being marketed as 42' when the bowsprit is included.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V hull (around 21° deadrise) provides steady tracking offshore and confident handling in a seaway.
- Notable performance: roughly 30 knot cruise, tested top speeds near 39.5 knots, and responsive handling.
- Functional interior for trips: forward queen berth, convertible dinette, single

head with separate shower, and a well-appointed galley with plentiful storage.

- Access to the dripless stuffing boxes may necessitate removing an exhaust manifold due to the large fishbox arrangement.
- Older boats on the market can require significant refurbishing; one reported refit cost was about \$700,000.
- Length designation can be misleading—some describe the hull as effectively a 39 foot design that’s marketed as 42' when the bowsprit is measured in.

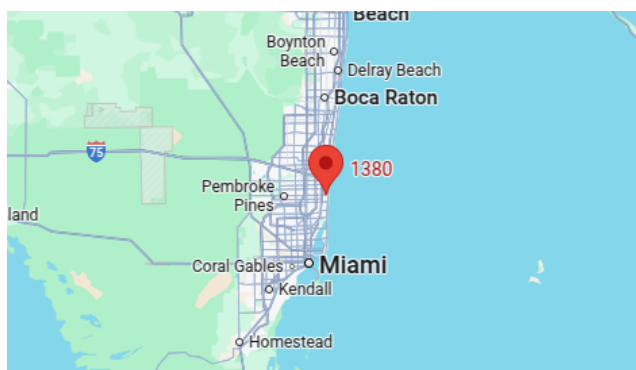
