OVERVIEW

The 25 from LILYBAEUM YACHT is a compact motor yacht built on a tough fiberglass hull and driven by a single, economical outboard engine. For availability, options, and purchasing guidance, contact Andrey Shestakov at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Selecting a 25

If you're seeking a manageable size paired with straightforward systems, the 25 is an excellent choice. Measuring 26 ft (7.9 m) overall with an 8 ft (2.55 m) beam and a shallow 1.312 ft (0.4 m) draft, it is well suited to sheltered anchorages and shallow approaches. The monohull layout and single Mercury diesel outboard make operation uncomplicated, while the 91.67-gallon fuel reserve and 21.13-gallon freshwater tank support comfortable full-day excursions.

Q: What type of yacht is the 25? A: It is a motor yacht monohull by LILYBAEUM YACHT built on a fiberglass hull.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: **LOA** is 26 ft (7.9 m), **Beam** is 8 ft (2.55 m), and **Draft** is 1.312 ft (0.4 m).

Q: What is the engine configuration? A: A single Mercury — **Outboard** and

Diesel — chosen for straightforward, efficient operation.

Q: What are the onboard capacities? A: **Fuel capacity** is 91.67 gal, and **Water capacity** is 21.13 gal.

Owner Experience Review

Configured and used primarily as a 25-foot dayboat, the 25 from LILYBAEUM YACHT is ideal for family outings and skippered charters. The full-open Lounge-Deck arrangement — featuring expansive sunpads, a wet bar, an on-deck shower, and plentiful storage — makes the cockpit the focal point for day trips. Finishing touches such as Flexiteek inlays elevate the aesthetic, while the deliberately limited below-deck area underscores the model's focus on daytime comfort rather than extended liveaboard cruising.

On the water, independent evaluations described the ride as 'dry and fun,' with press reports attributing this to the deep-V hull (approximately 22° deadrise) and a high-flared bow that enhance stability, handling, and spray protection in chop. The hull combines the robustness of a fisherman-style design with a day-boat layout, making light fishing a natural activity. Routine upkeep is uncomplicated with Mercury outboard propulsion: service intervals follow standard outboard procedures and access at the stern bracket and platform is straightforward, though the external mounting exposes the installation more directly to the marine environment than an inboard engine in a dedicated engine room.

Pros and Cons

- Deep-V hull and a high-flared bow help keep the deck dry and build confidence in choppy conditions.
- Open lounge deck with sunpads, wet bar, shower, and ample storage suits day cruising and charter use.
- Outboard propulsion simplifies routine service compared to inboard engine rooms.
- Minimal below-deck accommodation limits comfort for overnight or extended stays.
- Propulsion on the bracket/platform is more exposed to the marine environment than inboard setups.
- Public long-term owner feedback is limited, with most information coming from press, dealers, and charter listings.
