Q: What type of yacht is the 44 WhisperJet? A: It's a multi-role vessel — a motor yacht and capable cruiser — built in fiberglass and plastic and arranged as a Monohull.

Q: What are the performance figures? A: The 44 WhisperJet maintains a **cruise speed** of 22 kn (25.32 mph) and reaches a **top speed** of 24 kn (27.62 mph), making it well suited for confident coastal passages.

Q: What powers the 44 WhisperJet? A: Propulsion comes from **2 x Yanmar** engines installed as **Inboard** units running on **Diesel**, chosen for their reliability and efficiency.

Q: What are the key dimensions and capacities? A: **LOA** is 44 ft (13.41 m), **Beam** is 13 ft (4.14 m), and **Draft** is 8.202 ft (2.5 m). The boat carries **Fuel** 450 gal and **Fresh water** 164 gal, with a **Gross tonnage** of 12.5 GT.

Owner Experience Review

Owners select the 44 WhisperJet from LITTLE HARBOR for family-oriented cruising, weekend escapes, and exploring shallow bays. The combination of an approximate 2'–2.5' draft and waterjet propulsion (no exposed shaft or propeller) allows owners to beach the boat safely and access shoal anchorages, while also reducing the chance of marine fouling. In marinas and tight quarters the jet buckets and joystick controls deliver exceptional maneuverability, enabling near-instant stops and lateral moves; underway, the deep V hull with twin chines produces a steady ride through chop and minimizes wave slap at rest.

Aboard, owners praise the warm varnished cherry and teak joinery and the raised salon's notably low noise levels at speed, aided by a sound insulated engine compartment. Typical layouts include a forward centerline queen or a convertible U berth, paired with a functional galley and an L settee that

support short-term liveaboard use. The vessel provides usable thrust across a broad 1800–2800 rpm range, creating a relaxed cruising feel, though several owners report a drop in top speed or increased vibration when the jets require servicing. Routine access for maintenance is generally straightforward via large aft and deck hatches, but significant Hamilton waterjet work can be specialized and costly; impeller replacements are possible yet fiddly, prompting many owners to adhere to regular winter and jet service programs.

Pros and Cons

- Shallow draft (~2'–2.5') combined with jet drive allows exploration of shoals, beaching, and lowers fouling risk.
- Jet buckets and joystick controls produce precise low speed handling with car like stops and sideways moves.
- Warm, quiet raised salon and sensible liveaboard layouts make it well suited to family cruising.
- Extensive Hamilton waterjet repairs can be more expensive than work on conventional propulsion systems.
- Impeller replacement and jet servicing are intricate tasks often requiring specialist support.
- Some owners note vibration or diminished top speed when jets are not optimally tuned or following repairs.

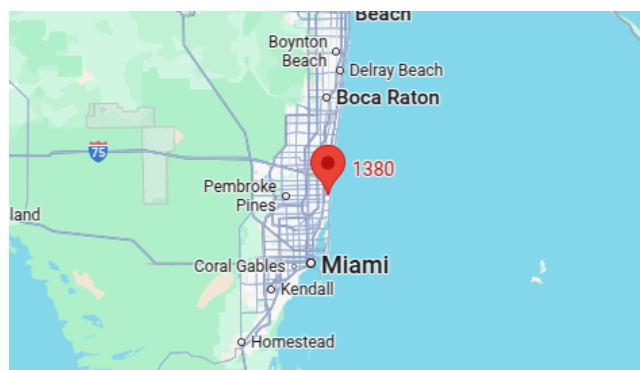
