Selecting a 112

Opting for the 112 is a choice for owners who value expansive interior volume and a construction pedigree they can count on. Measuring 112 ft (34.14 m) overall, with a notably broad 24 ft (7.29 m) beam and room to sleep 12, this yacht performs equally well for long-distance cruising or running a high-capacity charter program. Classified as a motor yacht within the wider motor yachts market, its fiberglass and plastic hull together with a fiberglass deck provide a balance of robustness and manageable upkeep. Owner Experience Review

Owners stepping aboard the 112 from Majesty Yachts often praise its versatility, noting how easily it transitions from private family cruising to commercial charter service and social weekend use. The main-deck owner's stateroom, complete with a private foredeck terrace and expansive floor-to-ceiling glazing, creates a home-like atmosphere, while six en-suite guest cabins and a beach club with direct sea access make hosting larger parties straightforward. Reviewers frequently emphasize the seamless indoor-outdoor connectivity: folding balconies, a luminous skylounge, generous deck dining and lounging areas, and a foredeck jacuzzi — features complemented by the contemporary interior design attributed in press to Phathom Studio.

On the water, the 112 presents as a semi-displacement hull form that reviewers describe as offering smooth, economical passages. Published figures indicate a top speed near 20 knots with a comfortable cruising window; the broad beam and an approximate ~185-ton displacement are credited with delivering stability both underway and at anchor. Sea trials referenced in previews report steady acceleration and composed handling rather than sharp responsiveness. For extended itineraries, aggregated listings reference a fuel capacity near 4,702 US gallons and an estimated 1,300-nm range at cruising speed, supporting longer voyage planning.

From an operational standpoint, comprehensive long-term maintenance trends are still emerging for this relatively new model. Anticipated service items reflect class norms: main engine servicing (MAN is specified in broker/specs, with MTU sometimes available across the brand's line), generator and stabilizer upkeep, and attention to sewage treatment systems when fitted to meet charter standards. Majesty Yachts has announced expanded service support, and general arrangement materials show conventional lower-deck machinery spaces with transom and beach-club access for easier servicing. Nevertheless, brokers recommend a full pre-purchase survey and a contractor review focused on service access and long-term maintenance planning.

Pros and Cons

- Family friendly layout with a main deck owner's suite, six en suite cabins, and multiple indoor outdoor lounges including folding balconies and a foredeck jacuzzi.
- Semi displacement hull delivers a smooth, efficient cruise with good seakeeping and a published range around 1,300 nm.
- Charter ready profile with commercial class options such as sewage treatment and enhanced communications to support compliance.
- Long term owner reliability and maintenance trends are not yet documented for this recent model.
- Published ~20 knot top speed and gentle acceleration may not suit speed focused buyers.
- Added systems for charter compliance (e.g., sewage treatment and comms) can increase service workload and oversight needs.

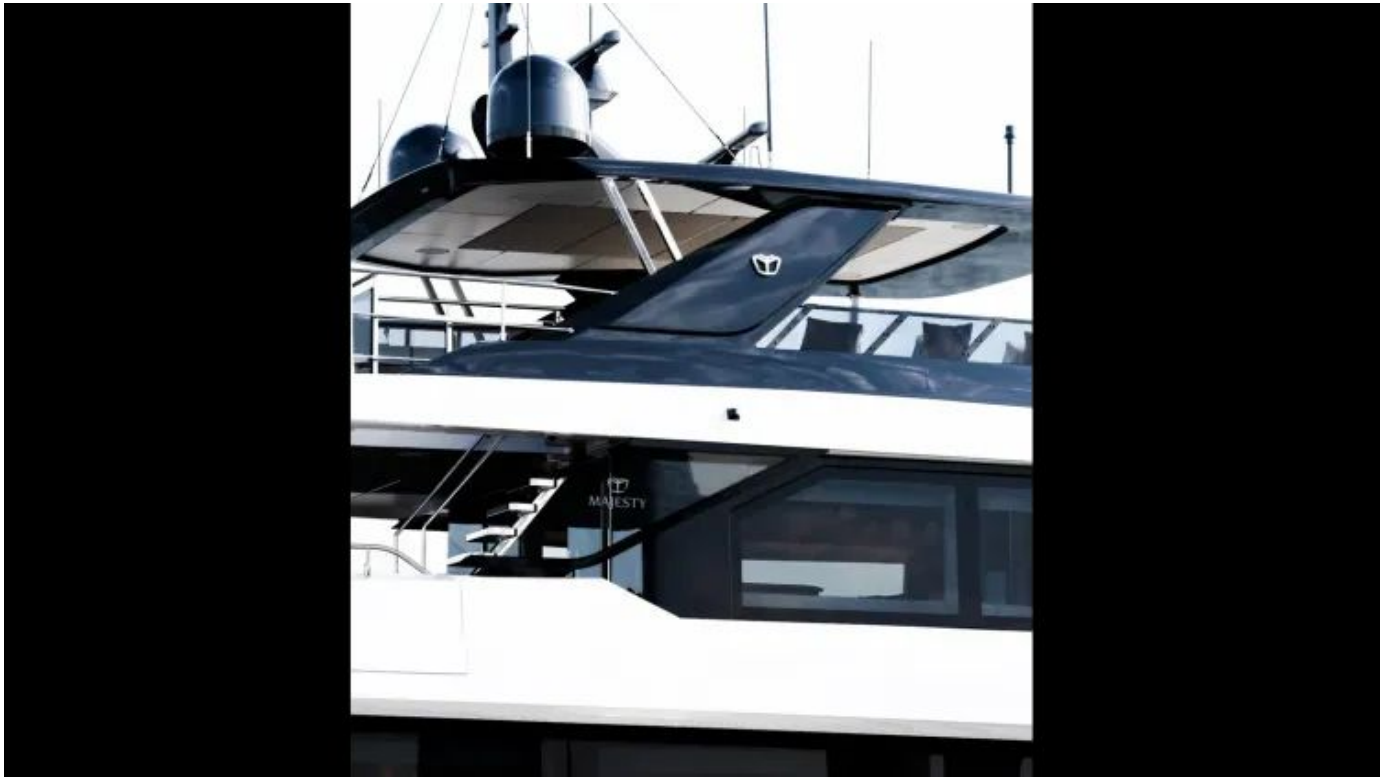

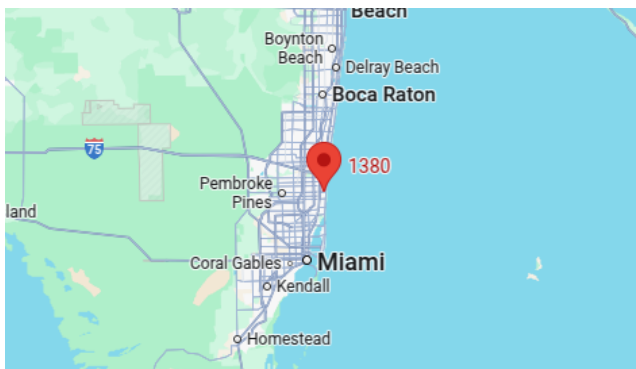
