OVERVIEW

The 145 from Majesty Yachts is a sophisticated motor yacht measuring 148 ft (45.25 m), constructed on a sturdy fiberglass construction hull with an FRP deck. Offering 420 GT of internal volume, interiors by Cristiano Gatto, and twin MTU inboard powerplants, this model is listed through Shestakov Yacht Sales — contact Andrey Shestakov for expert assistance in choosing and acquiring this yacht.

Selecting a 145

Opting for the 145 prioritizes substantial interior volume, a refined balance of performance and comfort, and a polished aesthetic. Its 26 ft (8.09 m) beam creates roomy living areas, while a 7.448 ft (2.27 m) draft increases cruising flexibility. The yacht achieves a top speed of 17 knots (19.56 mph) courtesy of twin MTU inboard engines. It offers accommodation for 12 people, sleeping space for 8 guests, and 9 crew berths—well suited to prolonged stays aboard. As a high-end motor yacht built on a fiberglass construction foundation, the [145] fuses efficient hull engineering with onboard comfort. Owner Experience Review

With the maiden hull ("Suzie Q") launched on April 24, 2026, owner narratives for the 145 by Majesty Yachts remain limited. Initial attention has focused on its strengths for private entertainment and long-range cruising: twin infinity style pools, a large beach club, and multiple terraces provide varied social zones, while a six cabin arrangement on the 45.25 m (148'4") platform accommodates 12 guests—an unusually high guest count for yachts of this dimension. Expansive floor to ceiling glazing and open sightlines maintain bright interiors, generally presented in a neutral palette enlivened by accent tones. Wellness features are integrated into the design, including a gym, an

infrared sauna, and dedicated spa facilities, positioning the 145 as well suited to lifestyle led or liveaboard use. The semi custom build strategy allows owners to tailor the stern, flybridge, and bow areas to prioritize either private cruising or light charter operations. Early previews describe on water behavior as tuned for solid sea keeping, but independent owner or captain sea trial accounts have not yet been published. Public listings have not released definitive cruise or service speed figures; VesselFinder confirms the hull's existence but does not report performance data. Real world handling and fuel consumption metrics will emerge as more hours are logged. As a newly introduced model, long term maintenance and reliability patterns remain undetermined. Early documentation references 2×2,400 hp MTUs, however comprehensive engine room schematics, recommended service intervals, and access considerations are not yet widely available. No recurring failure reports or established service cost trends have surfaced in owner or captain forums to date.

Pros and Cons

- Expansive guest entertainment provisions, including two pools and an ample beach club, support lengthy hosting and cruising agendas.
- The six cabin layout on a 45.25 m hull accommodates 12 guests, an unusually generous guest capacity for this size class.
- Semi custom options for the stern, flybridge, and bow enable owners to configure the yacht for private use or light chartering.
- Independent owner and captain sea trial reports are not yet accessible, limiting empirical handling feedback.
- Conclusive cruise and service speed figures, as well as fuel consumption data, have not been published.
- Long term maintenance records and reliability trends are still unknown given the model's recent launch.

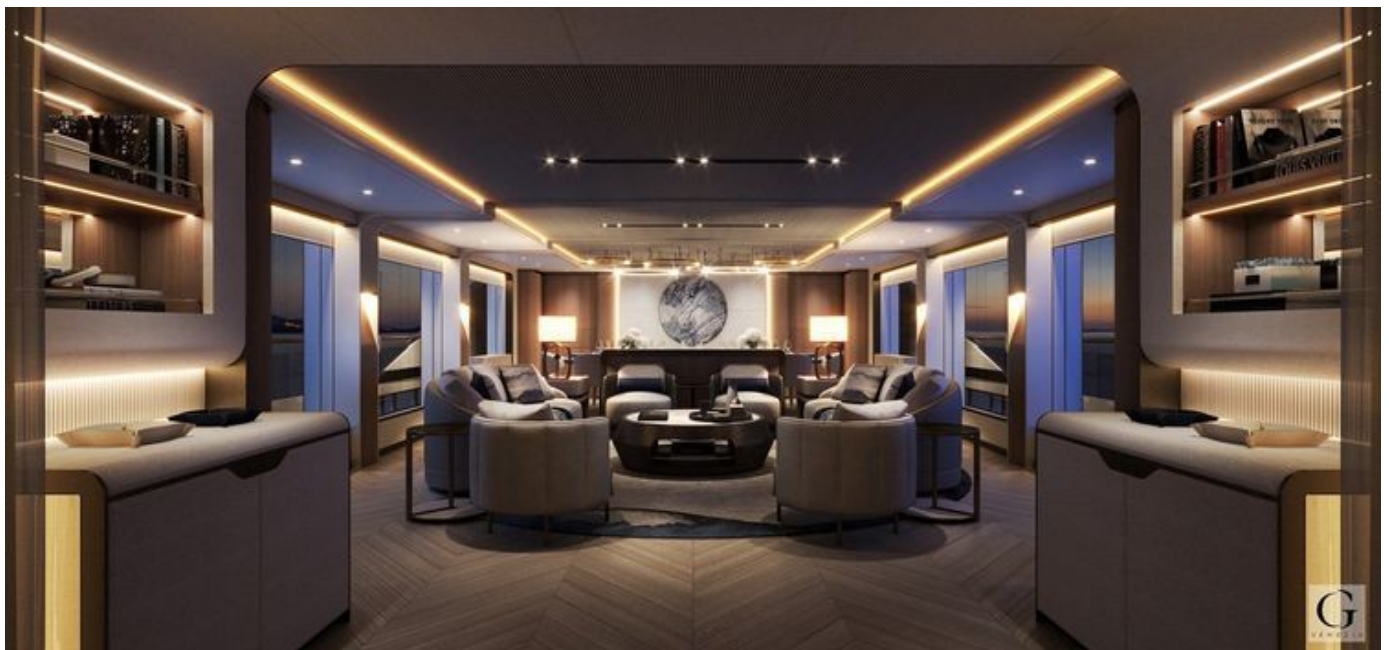
