OVERVIEW

The 25 Encore from MANITOU is a multi use motor yacht constructed as a pontoon featuring a durable aluminum hull. Measuring 26 ft (8.03 m) overall with an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam, it is propelled by a single Suzuki outboard running on gas/petrol for confident, efficient cruising and day use.

Selecting a 25 Encore

If your search focuses on a compact 26 foot pontoon capable of reaching speeds up to 48 kn (48 mph), the 25 Encore is a strong candidate. As a pontoon within the wider motor yacht category and fitted with an aluminum hull category construction, it provides a sturdy platform driven by a single Suzuki outboard. Questions and Answers

Q: What is the **top speed** of the 25 Encore? A: The published **top speed** is up to 48 kn (48 mph).

Q: What **engine** powers the 25 Encore? A: It is driven by 1 x Suzuki **engine** , an **Outboard** that runs on **Gas/Petrol** .

Q: What are the **LOA** and **beam** of the 25 Encore? A: The **LOA** measures 26 ft (8.03 m) and the **beam** measures 8 ft (2.59 m).

Q: What is the **fuel capacity** ? A: The vessel's **fuel capacity** is 90 gal.

Q: Which **categories** does it belong to, and what is the **hull** type? A: It is classified as a motor yacht arranged as a pontoon and sits in the categorized aluminum hull group.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly praise the 25 Encore from MANITOU for its adaptability—suitable for family outings, daytime cruising, and extended social gatherings. Community feedback and sea trials highlight a thoughtful layout: forward bow lounges, a rear booth style dinette, a discreet changing compartment, and substantial storage beneath the seats. Several owners report comfortably accommodating up to 14 people along with provisions for a full day; available upgrades such as faux teak decking, enhanced audio systems, and a comfort focused helm with a tilt adjusted engine control further improve long day usability. Anglers often opt for the Pro Angler version to prioritize fishing features over leisure appointments.

When underway, testers such as BoatTEST note the hull exhibits V like cornering behavior, leaning into turns with roughly a 10° bank and achieving plane in a very short time—BoatTEST recorded planing in under about three seconds during a 150 hp evaluation. The SeaStar hydraulic steering has been described as somewhat firm, giving the helm a slower, more deliberate feel. Many owners choose SHP/tri tube setups and fit engines up to 350 hp for watersports, reporting GPS speeds near 53 mph with a light load (1–5 people) and about 48 mph when carrying 6–14 aboard. Routine maintenance is simplified by an integrated transom featuring a flat work surface, though higher horsepower outboards increase service frequency and ownership costs; forum discussions reference earlier Yamaha 350 flywheel issues that have been largely resolved over time, aside from the need for replacement

when affected.

Pros and Cons

- Pro: Expansive, flexible seating arrangement including bow lounges, aft booth style seating, a hidden changing room, and plentiful under seat storage.
- Pro: Assured on water handling that banks about 10° in turns and can plane in under roughly three seconds in testing.
- Pro: SHP/tri tube combinations with up to 350 hp provide robust tow sport performance and owner reported GPS peaks near ~53 mph with a light complement.
- Con: SeaStar hydraulic steering is often reported as on the firm side, producing a more measured helm feel.
- Con: Fitting higher power outboards increases maintenance demands and long term ownership expenses.
- Con: Some owners recalled legacy Yamaha 350 flywheel issues; while many of those problems have been addressed, replacements remain necessary when failures occurred.

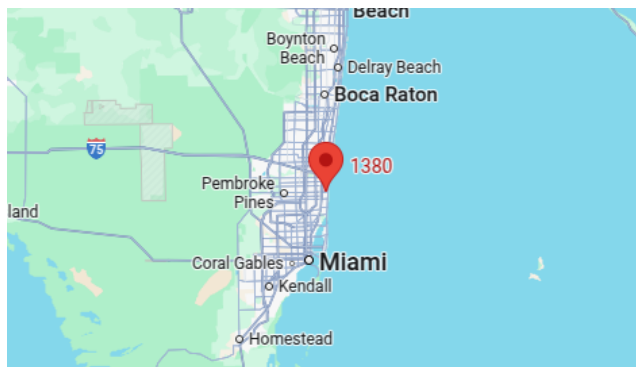
