The vessel combines brisk performance with distinctive styling and meticulous finishing by MAORI.

Owner Experience Review

Owners frequently choose the 54XL by MAORI for its high performance dayboat character and entertaining capability, comfortably accommodating roughly 12–16 guests across expansive fore and aft sunpads and a roomy cockpit lounge. It also serves well as a tender or chase boat for larger yachts and excels on short weekend runs, sandbar excursions, and quick family hops — more suited to Bahamas style legs than extended ocean crossings. Belowdecks, a single dedicated cabin, a full head, a galley, and a convertible settee make occasional overnighting straightforward while acknowledging the limitations for long term liveaboard privacy.

On the water, owner reports and listings commonly cite top speeds in the 48–50 knot range when fitted with MAN i6 850s on surface drives, and the vessel's motion is described as firm and athletic with lively acceleration — the kind of character reviewers liken to “the Italian sports car of the sea.” Bow and stern thrusters simplify close quarters maneuvering, although, as with any surface drive installation, reverse and slow speed handling require a measured touch. Visually, the yacht draws attention; multiple observers have called it “one of the best looking yachts I’ve ever seen.”

Daytime comfort is a strong selling point: generous sunpads, an open cockpit

dining area seating about six, and what one description terms an “open social area for twelve people to sunbathe.” Typical specs include custom finishes, air conditioning, high quality audio/AV systems, and ample storage. Ownership considerations include routine surface drive inspections — extra wear on props in sandy or abrasive conditions, trim and hydraulic checks, and hub maintenance are known service items — and the option to add Seakeeper gyros for a significant improvement in comfort, with associated initial cost and ongoing maintenance. The MAN i6 850 engines adhere to manufacturer service schedules, and access for service is usually via a large hydraulic hatch rather than a full walk in engine room in most setups.

Pros and Cons

- Performance oriented handling with listed ~48–50 knot speeds and quick surface drive punch delivers a genuinely sporty experience.
- Open social deck plan with fore/aft sunpads and cockpit dining for about six suits entertaining roughly 12–16 guests.
- Versatile for tender/chase boat duties and short weekend hops, with a cabin, full head, galley, and a convertible settee for occasional overnights.
- Surface drives require attentive low speed/reverse handling and regular inspection, with faster prop wear in sandy/abrasive waters.
- Optional Seakeeper gyros improve comfort but add upfront cost and recurring scheduled maintenance.
- Interior offers limited privacy for extended liveaboard use, and engine access is via a large hatch rather than a full walk in space.
