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OVERVIEW

The Marquis 65 is a 64 ft luxury motor yacht positioned in the motor yachts market. Built on a tried-and-true fiberglass hull with a fiberglass deck, it delivers a confident blend of seakeeping and cruising comfort, typically cruising at 22 knots with a 32-knot top speed. Selecting a 65

Opting for the Marquis 65 emphasizes a balance between capable performance and livable onboard accommodations. Its 64 ft (19.53 m) LOA combined with a 17 ft (5.46 m) beam produces substantial interior volume for entertaining and longer cruises, while the fairly deep draft contributes to a steady, assured motion underway. As a motor yacht within the broader motor yachts category and constructed on a fiberglass construction hull, it offers durability and relatively straightforward upkeep. With sleeping arrangements for six and two heads, it appeals to owners who want brisk passages alongside practical liveaboard features.

Features of the Model

- Performance profile: comfortable cruising at 22 knots (25.32 mph) with a 32-knot (36.83 mph) top speed for efficient passages.
- Propulsion: twin inboard MTU diesel engines provide strong, dependable thrust and straightforward maintenance.
- Layout: accommodates 6 with 2 heads, offering practical and comfortable sleeping and sanitary arrangements for family or guests.

- Build: fiberglass deck laid over a fiberglass hull structure for durability and long-term serviceability.
- Capacities: 1,200 gallons of fuel and 200 gallons of fresh water to support extended cruising ranges.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and reviewers commonly praise the Marquis 65 as well suited to owner-operators seeking family cruising and weekend escapes. Low-speed handling draws favorable comments thanks to joystick control combined with bow and stern thrusters, simplifying close-quarters dock work. Guests often cite the roomy flybridge and salon as standout features, while the three-stateroom arrangement—with a generous lower foyer and a substantial VIP/midship master—creates a sense of space that belies the yacht's overall length. Fine interior joinery in cherry and pomelle sapelle contributes to an upscale feel, and the on-deck galley and dining configuration streamlines entertaining.

Underway, observers report generally good performance and sea manners,

and the model is often described as capable of longer-range cruising. Nevertheless, some owners feel it underperforms relative to expectations, noting a pronounced bow-up running attitude; there is also an anecdote of hull flex in roughly six-foot seas that, when pushed in poor conditions, reportedly resulted in shattered forward hull windows.

Owner feedback is more variable regarding systems and build detail. Several forum posts mention undersized deck hardware and missing backing plates, alongside electrical and windlass protection shortcomings—some reports even describe fires linked to inadequately protected systems. Servicing certain equipment can be tight on access, and commenters note inconsistent fit-and-finish across the production run; many pre-owned examples (often identified as 65 or later marketed as 690) typically show items that benefit from attention, service, or refit.

Pros and Cons

- Owner-operator friendly maneuvering with joystick plus bow and stern thrusters.
- Spacious flybridge and salon with good entertaining flow and on-deck amenities.
- Three-stateroom layout with a roomy lower foyer and high-end cherry and pomelle sapelle joinery.
- Some owners criticize a slower pace and bow-high running attitude.
- Anecdotal reports describe hull flex in heavy seas causing shattered forward hull windows.
- Forum reports cite undersized hardware, lack of backing plates, and electrical/windlass protection issues including fires.
