Q: What is the classification of the 4200 SCR? A: It is categorized as a motor yacht in the motor yacht class, built on a fiberglass platform hull that provides

Owner Experience Review

Many owners pick the Maxum 4200 SCR precisely for its mixed-use capability: comfortable day trips with friends that easily convert to family overnight stays. The two genuine staterooms and two heads — featuring a forward queen and an enclosed mid cabin — deliver meaningful privacy, and the salon/galley layout is frequently cited as exceptionally well equipped for a vessel of this size.

Aboard, the wide modified V hull (roughly 14'-15' beam) creates a steady, motor yacht-like motion and significantly cuts down rolling. Owners and brokers report that about 18° of deadrise aft yields predictable handling in

choppy conditions. With twin 450 hp Cummins V drive diesels, typical cruise speeds land in the low to mid 20 knot band while top speeds can reach roughly 27–28 knots; one broker listing indicates a “cruise at 2300 RPM and burns 32 GPH, top end 2600 RPM.” Large fuel tanks (≈480 gal) and generous water storage make longer coastal runs comfortable and less range restricted.

When it comes to maintenance, used listings often show attentive owners addressing major service items: rebuilt aftercoolers, replaced exhaust tubing and hose clamps, and work on injectors or injection pumps. The hydraulic lift for the aft cockpit deck gives convenient access to the engine room for routine servicing. Keep in mind brand realities: Maxum is no longer in production, so replacement parts often come through aftermarket suppliers or Brunswick/Bayliner channels. Forum discussions also note occasional fit and finish issues and recommend careful inspection for moisture intrusion or wear in stringers and the transom on older examples — a detailed survey is advised.

Pros and Cons

- Two staterooms and two heads provide true family friendly overnights and solid privacy (queen forward, enclosed mid cabin).
- A stable, predictable ride— the beamy modified V hull effectively minimizes roll.
- Substantial tankage, including roughly 480 gal of fuel and ample water capacity, supports extended coastal running.
- Handling is oriented toward motoryacht comfort rather than sports boat responsiveness.
- The discontinued brand means parts and support can require aftermarket sources or Brunswick/Bayliner channels.
- Older examples may present fit and finish shortcomings and potential moisture/stringer/transom concerns; a thorough survey is recommended.
