## OVERVIEW

The 58 from MCKINNA is a polished motor yacht built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull and driven by twin inboard Caterpillar diesel engines. Measuring 58 ft (17.68 m) overall with a 17 ft (5.26 m) beam, it combines seakeeping and interior volume for owners who prize reliable cruising and sensible capacity. Opt for the 58 when you want a 58 foot platform featuring inboard diesel dependability, a classic motor yacht silhouette, and the longevity of a fiberglass and plastic construction. Key specifications include a typical cruise of 20 kn (20 mph) and a top end near 23 kn (23 mph), fuel capacity of 1,000 gallons for extended passages, a 270 gallon freshwater tank, and 2 heads for onboard comfort. Q: What kind of yacht is the 58 by MCKINNA? A: It is a **58-foot** motor yacht constructed on a **fiberglass and plastic** hull, intended for dependable cruising.

Q: What are the expected speeds? A: The 58 typically cruises at about **20 kn (20 mph)** and can reach a **maximum speed** of **23 kn (23 mph)** .

Q: What powers this model? A: Propulsion comes from twin **Caterpillar inboard diesel engines** , providing proven and reliable drive.

Q: What are the key capacities and dimensions? A: It carries **1,000 gal fuel** , **270 gal water** , includes **2 heads** , has a **beam** of 17 ft (5.26 m), and a **max draft** of 12.576 ft (3.8333 m).

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and brokers commonly portray the 58 by MCKINNA as a practical, family oriented pilothouse yacht with a useful 3 stateroom/2 head layout. The design places the master amidships and situates the galley at pilothouse level, complemented by a generous salon finished in high gloss joinery; the flybridge accommodates seating for roughly eight and the aft deck provides a sociable space ideal for weekend gatherings. Listings and owner reports also note its suitability for liveaboard lifestyles and longer coastal passages, helped by fuel capacity near 1,000 gallons.

When underway, typical installations using roughly 800 hp Caterpillar powerplants produce cruising speeds around 20 knots and tops in the mid 20s. Owners have called it a reasonably capable seaboat, though some find the ride a bit wet; many examples are fitted with stabilizers, but at least one owner reported that air stabilizers provided little benefit in genuine seas.

Routine maintenance comments are mixed. One knowledgeable owner

criticized a complex electrical arrangement with extensive wiring and solenoids, plus a fuel system containing more than 20 unlabeled valves; listings also note the engine room can be somewhat compact and is normally reached from the aft deck or lazarette. Climate control has been mentioned as a concern — one owner felt boats with two chillers still ran under A/C and were hard to cool down — and brokers frequently advise checking the Onan genset and recent generator hours/condition during inspection.

## Pros and Cons

- Versatile 3 stateroom/2 head layout suits family cruising and liveaboard use.
- Spacious salon/galley and flybridge seating for about eight support entertaining on weekends.
- Coastal capability with ~1,000 gallons of fuel and a typical ~20 knot cruise on 800 hp Cats.
- Ride can be wet, and at least one owner reported air stabilizers that didn't help much in a real sea.
- Electrical and fuel systems have been described as overcomplicated, with many unlabeled valves and tight engine room service access.
- At least one owner reported the boat was under A/C'd and hard to get truly cold even with two chillers.
