The 37 OPEN from Midnight Express Powerboats is a performance-oriented motor yacht built on a versatile center console layout and a robust fiberglass hull. Its triple Mercury outboard propulsion and generous fuel tanks make it well suited for spirited day runs and longer adventure cruises, with transaction support and brokerage expertise available through Shestakov Yacht Sales.

## Selecting a 37 OPEN

---

Opting for the 37 OPEN means prioritizing a 37-foot vessel that combines triple outboard power with the practical efficiencies of a center console platform. Measuring 11 ft (3.5 m) across the beam and 37 ft (11.28 m) LOA, it strikes a balance between generous deck area and nimble handling. If you value contemporary fiberglass construction in a modern motor yacht format, driven by three Mercury gas outboards, this model suits active coastal cruising, tender duties, and performance-minded owners.

## Questions and Answers

Q: What is the primary class of the 37 OPEN? A: The vessel is a motor yacht arranged in a center console layout and constructed on a fiberglass hull.

Q: What powers the boat, and what fuel does it use? A: **Engines:** Three **Mercury** outboards; **Fuel: Gas** . This triple-outboard arrangement delivers responsive acceleration and engine redundancy.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: **LOA:** 37 ft (11.28 m); **Beam:** 11 ft (3.5 m); **Max Draft:** 5.468 ft (1.6666 m). These proportions provide a steady platform with agile handling inherent to a center console platform.

Q: What materials are used for the hull and deck? A: **Hull:** fiberglass construction; **Deck:** Fiberglass. The combination emphasizes a favorable strength-to-weight ratio.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners of the 37 OPEN by Midnight Express Powerboats report using the boat for family outings and short overnight trips, benefiting from a single-cabin console that includes an enclosed head and shower. For daytime use it performs well on everything from sandbar gatherings to waterfront restaurant hops. Listings and charter feedback also depict it as a versatile platform: one TripAdvisor reviewer said they were "totally comfortable and at ease" aboard the 37 OPEN during a day excursion. The broad 11'6" beam contributes to a spacious, secure feel and supports aft U lounge arrangements, a convertible forward table/sunpad, and multiple helm seating options.

On the water, owner comments and broker notes consistently highlight steady, dependable performance. With a deep V hull (around 22 degrees) combined with a wide beam, the boat tends to offer a stable, relatively dry ride through swell and chop. Power configurations vary, but brokers often note a relaxed cruise speed above 40 mph; some high powered, quad Racing examples in listings claim extremely high top speeds (up to roughly 84 knots), so actual performance will depend on the installed engine package and vessel load.

Maintenance aligns with the boat's performance focus: triple or quad Verado/Mercury Racing outboards are common and typically bring higher routine service and parts expenses compared with smaller setups. Access to outboards is generally straightforward beneath the cowlings, yet modern electronic integrations (for example, Garmin/Mercury gateways and ECMs noted in listings) frequently require dealer-level diagnostics for warranty work or complex troubleshooting. There is no evident, fleet-wide failure pattern specific to Midnight Express Powerboats in public forums; standard high-performance outboard care and a thorough pre-purchase engine survey are recommended.

## Pros and Cons

- Wide 11'6" beam and a deep V hull yield a stable, dry ride with confident handling in chop.
- High performance with a comfortable 40+ mph cruise, and options up to quad Racing power for longer-range runs.
- Flexible deck and single-cabin layout support fishing, day-charter use, sandbar stops, and overnighting for two.
- Triple or quad Verado/Mercury Racing packages raise routine service and parts costs.
- Electronics and engine diagnostics typically require dealer tools and expertise.
- One-cabin plan limits comfortable overnight capacity to two adults.
