# OVERVIEW

---

Designed for speed and versatility, the 43 Open by Midnight Express Powerboats is a performance-oriented motor yacht that pairs a roomy center console layout with a resilient fiberglass and plastic hull. Driven by four Mercury outboards, it accelerates aggressively, comfortably cruises at 40 knots, and can reach top speeds in the vicinity of 75 knots.

## Selecting a 43 Open

---

Opt for the 43 Open when you need a 43 ft (13.13 m) platform with a 12 ft (3.81 m) beam that delivers dependable performance around a 40 knot cruise and up to 75 knots at maximum. Its center console design offers practical single head accommodations and substantial fuel and water reserves for extended day runs. Constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull and fiberglass decking, it strikes a balance between high speed, structural integrity, and comfortable day boating. Q: What type of yacht is the 43 Open? A: It's a high performance motor yacht

laid out as a versatile center console and built on a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: How fast does it go? A: The 43 Open is capable of a **cruise speed of 40 kn (40 mph)** and a **top speed up to 75 kn (75 mph)** .

Q: What powers this model? A: Four **Mercury** outboard engines running on **Gas** produce the performance characteristic of the 43 Open.

Q: What are the key dimensions and capacities? A: LOA **43 ft (13.13 m)** , beam **12 ft (3.81 m)** , minimum draft **6.562 ft (2 m)** , fuel **450 gal** , fresh water **75 gal** , and **1 head** .

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and brokers consistently market the 43 Open by Midnight Express Powerboats as a speed focused day boat with a layout optimized for entertaining. It regularly accommodates large groups for day or weekend outings—one owner reports comfortable cruising with 25 people aboard—and the open center console arrangement also converts neatly for offshore fishing when outfitted. Its deckplan makes it a favorite for demos, charters, and special events because it handles crowds well.

On the water, typical quad Verado packages supply the brisk performance buyers expect: accounts reference mid/upper 70s to 80+ mph runs, and one owner recorded 78 mph with eight people aboard and 440 gallons of fuel. With higher output Verado choices the acceleration is notably sharp, while the twin step hull combined with a generous 12 ft 6 in beam helps the boat track

quickly, run smoothly, and remain remarkably dry for a 43 foot center console. Reviews also emphasize that the model displays confident offshore behavior for its size bracket.

Comfort prioritizes open air social areas: cockpit and forward lounge spaces dominate, leaving the cabin modest in scale—usually a small guest berth with optional air conditioning rather than a full liveaboard interior. Helm ergonomics receive positive mention (one owner describes the dash as 'amazing'), and many owners choose to customize audio, seating, and protective covers rather than install a comprehensive galley. Ownership requires attention to maintenance and budget, since four or more outboards increase routine service demands, bespoke systems add to upkeep, and certain configurations affect service access; despite that, owners note practical touches like a single key that starts all four engines and straightforward access to the outboards.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Entertainment forward layout accommodates large day groups; an owner reports cruising with 25 people.
- Quad Verado configurations produce mid/upper 70s to 80+ mph performance with strong acceleration.
- Twin step hull and wide beam contribute to a stable, smooth, and notably dry offshore ride.
- Four to five outboards substantially increase routine maintenance scope and associated costs.
- Compact cabin with limited galley amenities suits day use rather than extended liveaboard cruises.
- Extensive customization and additional systems can raise lifecycle maintenance and operational complexity.
