---

Presenting the 70 ST by MONACHUS YACHTS — a motor yacht in the Motor Yacht class built with a fiberglass hull. Conceived by MONACHUS YACHTS in its own design studio, the 70 ST pairs efficient performance with well-appointed living spaces. For purchase guidance, Shestakov Yacht Sales — led by broker Andrey Shestakov — will assist you through the inquiry, inspection, and handover processes.

## Selecting a 70 ST

---

Opt for the 70 ST if you require a 70 foot platform capable of steady 24 knot cruising and bursts up to 34 knots, combined with practical liveaboard accommodation. The layout sleeps six guests, includes three heads and a separate crew cabin, making it suitable for family cruising or owner-operated programs with crew support. Its Modified V Hull is engineered to provide confidence in a variety of sea states.

## Questions and Answers

Q: What are the cruising and top speeds of the 70 ST? A: The yacht achieves a **cruising speed** of 24 kn (27.62 mph) and a **top speed** of 34 kn (39.13 mph).

Q: How many guests and crew can stay aboard? A: The yacht offers

**accommodation** for up to 6 guests, including **3 heads** . A separate **crew** area contains **1 cabin** with **2 beds** .

Q: Who designed the hull and interior? A: Both the **hull** and **interior** were created in house by MONACHUS YACHTS, featuring a **Hull configuration** of Modified V-Hull.

Q: What is the construction of the hull and deck? A: The **hull** is built from fiberglass and the **deck** is constructed in **GRP** .

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and charter operators running the 70 ST from MONACHUS YACHTS report it as a well matched boat for family cruising, week long charters, and lively day trips in the Mediterranean or South Florida. Underway, the deep V hull and pronounced, sharp bow cut through head seas with composure, and when stabilisation is engaged both underway and at anchor the vessel exhibits notably quiet, smooth motion.

Feedback highlights a dependable 24 knot cruise in typical conditions, with higher cruise and top speeds reported depending on the IPS option fitted; joystick/DPS systems make low speed manoeuvring uncomplicated. The interior plan promotes socialising and efficient charter turnover: generous foredeck sunpad areas, flexible 3 or 4 cabin configurations including a full beam aft master, and on the first charter configured hull a four cabin setup. The L shaped galley with a villa sized refrigerator and the seamless flow from galley to saloon to cockpit support liveaboard comfort and busy guest operations.

From a maintenance and ownership perspective, the yacht benefits from an exceptionally roomy engine room with floor access and gas spring hatches, improving serviceability. The standard powertrain is centered on Volvo Penta D13 IPS (IPS1200/1350); community experience with IPS pods, seals, and transmissions indicates potentially higher lifecycle maintenance costs compared with conventional shaft drives, so owners should plan an appropriate maintenance budget. As the model is relatively new — first hulls launched in 2022 — comprehensive long term private owner reliability data is still limited.

## Pros and Cons

- Deep V hull with a tall, sharp bow offers confident seakeeping and CE Category A capability for offshore passages.
- Stabilisation both at anchor and underway yields a quiet, comfortable ride with a common 24 knot cruise.
- Versatile 3–4 cabin configurations including a full beam aft master, expansive foredeck, and a practical galley–salon–cockpit circulation that suits both private ownership and charter.
- IPS pods may incur higher service and repair expenses compared with traditional shaft systems; factor this into ownership costs.
- Limited long term owner and failure records because the model has only recently entered production.
- Performance figures (cruise and top speed) vary by IPS choice (1200 vs 1350); confirm the exact propulsion package on any individual boat.
