OVERVIEW

The 65 MCY from Monte Carlo Yachts is a luxury motor yacht within the motor yacht class, built on a fiberglass/composite hull. Its overall length is 65 ft (19.81 m) and the beam measures 18 ft (5.49 m), offering a blend of roomy interior volume and elegant exterior proportions. Owner Experience Review

Across professional reviews and broker descriptions, the 65 MCY is frequently characterized as a "mini megayacht for the owner-operator." Owners favor it for easy single handed operation and extended cruising, while families appreciate the raised saloon, expansive flybridge, and generous aft deck as social spaces. Many listings show examples configured for co-ownership or charter, highlighting the model's adaptability between private use and program operation.

On the water, feedback emphasizes confident handling and dependable seakeeping, including composed behavior in chop. The twin MAN V8 installation is reported to deliver lively response and robust power, with reviews citing an approximate 26-knot cruising speed. Together these traits make the 65 MCY engaging to helm while keeping guests comfortable underway.

Inside, at least one published appraisal notes the interior "looks, feels, functions, and even smells like a megayacht," pointing to fine veneers, stone detailing, and premium textile choices. Common layouts seen in listings include a raised main-deck saloon with a main-deck galley, a spacious master suite, plus three additional cabins and three heads in addition to crew quarters. Practicality belowdecks is also praised: mechanical rooms feature generous overhead clearance and accessibility for maintenance, and testers call out Monte Carlo Yachts' modular interior trays bonded into the hull as aiding fit and potential service access. One listing reported an engine failure

that was subsequently corrected with a warranty replacement; as with most production boats, warranty scope can vary between structural and systems coverage, so buyers should examine service history and paperwork carefully.

Pros and Cons

- Described as a "mini megayacht for the owner-operator," with upscale interior materials and finish.
- Confident handling and solid seakeeping, driven by responsive MAN V8 power and an approximate 26-knot cruise.
- Social, spacious layout (raised saloon, large flybridge, aft deck) and mechanical spaces designed with high overhead clearance for serviceability.
- At least one listing notes an engine failure that was addressed with a warranty replacement, so prospective buyers should review maintenance records closely.
- Warranty coverage may differ between structural components and onboard systems, following common production-yacht practice.
- Several examples are set up for co-ownership or charter, meaning service and usage histories can vary from strictly private yachts.
