## OVERVIEW

---

Crafted by Monte Carlo Yachts, the 86 is an elegant motor yacht built on a fiberglass and plastic hull that marries seagoing capability with long distance liveaboard comfort. Offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, this model is aimed at owners who prioritize velocity, expansive living areas, and refined styling.

## Selecting a 86

---

Deciding if the 86 fits your plans starts with the type of cruising you intend to do. If dependable, efficient passages are a priority, the 24 knot cruising speed combined with substantial fuel reserves allows for versatile route planning. If access to shallow marinas and protected anchorages matters, factor in the 6.102 ft draft while the 18 ft beam delivers stability and generous interior volume. Coordinate with Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov to match your desired layouts, optional equipment, and crew arrangements to your cruising destinations.

## Features of the Model

---

- Confident performance: a comfortable 24 knot cruise with a top capability reaching 29 knots to keep itineraries flexible.
- Efficient propulsion: twin MAN inboard diesel engines provide dependable, widely serviceable power.
- Strong construction: a fiberglass and plastic hull combined with a fiberglass deck for durability and easier upkeep.
- Liveaboard comfort: accommodation arrangements supported by 4 heads and substantial tank capacities.
- Balanced dimensions: an 86 ft LOA and an 18 ft beam deliver significant

onboard volume without sacrificing handling.

## Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 86? A: It is a motor yacht constructed on a

fiberglass and plastic hull to offer a blend of durability and balanced onboard performance.

Q: What are the performance figures for cruising and top speed? A: The 86 lists a **cruise speed** of 24 kn (27.62 mph) and a **maximum speed** of 29 kn (33.37 mph), suitable for maintaining efficient schedules at sea.

Q: Which engines power the yacht? A: Twin **MAN inboard diesel** engines (2 units) supply reliable propulsion with serviceability available across major yachting centers.

Q: How suitable is the yacht for extended trips? A: With a **fuel capacity** of 1,981.29 gal, **water capacity** of 396.26 gal, and four heads, the 86 is well equipped for extended cruising itineraries.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners commonly deploy the Monte Carlo Yachts 86 for family cruising and extended passages through the Bahamas and Caribbean, alternating multi-week voyages with frequent weekend outings. Many operate the yacht with minimal crew or as owner-operators; one owner commented, "this boat is really easy to handle," noting frequent single-handing. The model also sees service in charter fleets focused on private luxury charters.

On the water, both owners and reviewers praise its seakeeping—one owner described it as holding the sea "like a tank" during Bahamas runs. Professional sea trials note an athletic, responsive character for an 86-foot platform that "handles like a thoroughbred," with recorded speeds ranging from roughly 9.7 kn at 900 rpm up to about 31.4 kn at 2313 rpm; cruising comfortably in the

mid 20s is commonly reported, although a test day yielded a top speed slightly below some expectations.

A typical four cabin layout with a full beam amidships master, a luminous, spacious main salon, and generous flybridge and foredeck lounging areas cater to extended stays—owners frequently mention enjoying the foredeck lounges with a glass of champagne while at anchor. The model offers broad customization choices. Routine ownership reflects the realities of a large diesel 86 footer: engine room accessibility is appreciated for maintenance, but used examples often require refits such as exhaust overhauls and replacement of hydraulic lines for doors and the tender garage, and owners report elevated ongoing service and operating expenses.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Strong seakeeping that "holds its sea" on Bahamas runs provides confidence for offshore passages.
- Manageable for an experienced owner to handle, with reports of effective single handing on the 86.
- Bright, voluminous interior spaces with a large flybridge and foredeck lounges, accommodating common four cabin arrangements and numerous customization options.
- Routine service and operating costs are substantial for an 86 footer powered by large diesel engines.
- Hydraulic systems for doors and the garage are known maintenance items on pre-owned examples.
- Some sea trials have recorded top speeds below anticipated figures despite comfortable cruising in the mid 20 knot range.

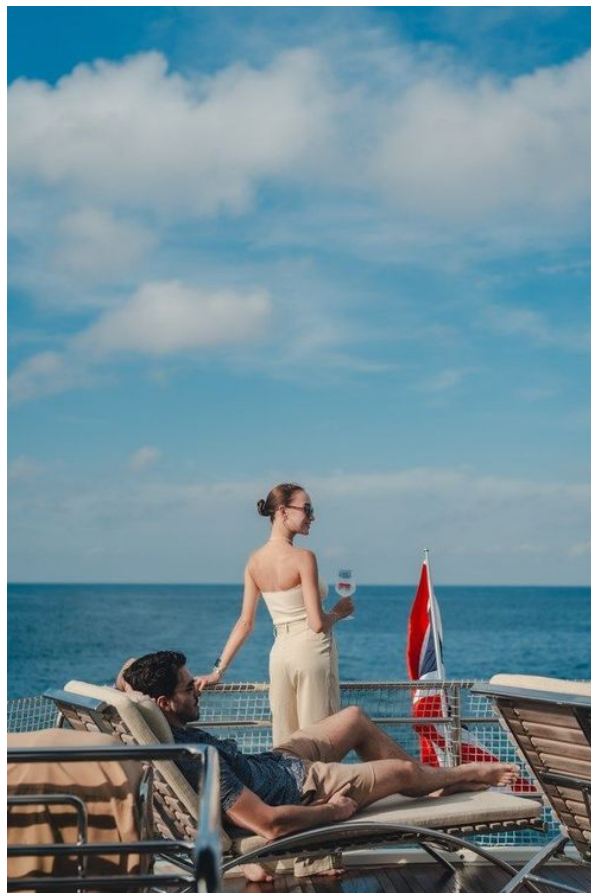

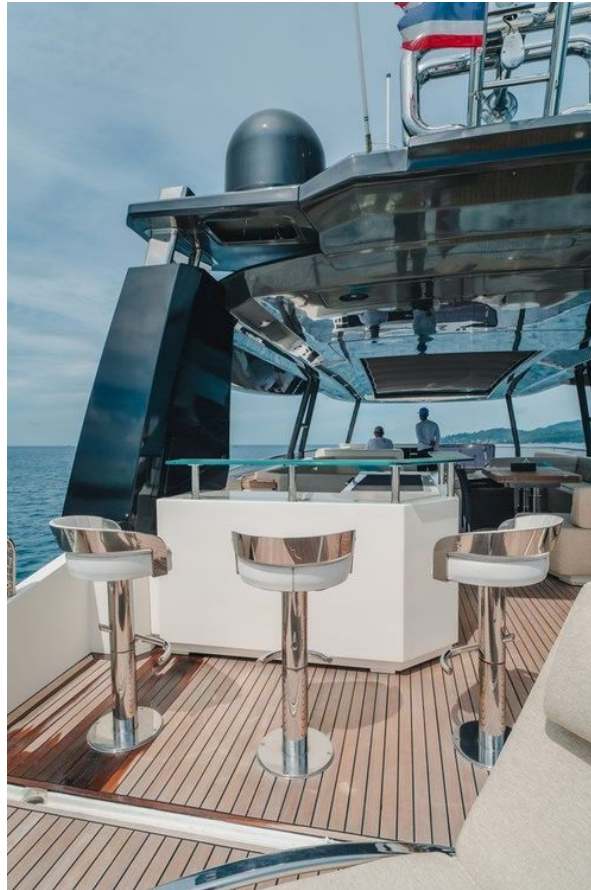
