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# OVERVIEW

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The MCY96 from Monte Carlo Yachts is a 95 ft (29.2 m) motor yacht that sits in the motor yachts segment. Laid upon a fiberglass hull platform and configured for planing, the exterior naval architecture is credited to Nuvolari Lenard Sri while the interiors are by Nuvolari Lenard. With a 22 ft (6.94 m) beam, sleeping arrangements for up to 12 guests, and a top capability near 24 kn, it offers a balance of internal volume, onboard comfort, and performance.

## Selecting a MCY96

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Opting for the MCY96 is a logical choice when you value a roomy 95 ft motor yacht that pairs competent cruising ability with sophisticated Nuvolari Lenard Sri exterior lines and Nuvolari Lenard interiors. Whether your priority is extended family cruising or hosting guests, the layout supports up to 12 people with six heads and distinct crew quarters. ## Questions and Answers

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Q: What type of yacht is the MCY96? A: The vessel is a motor yacht that falls within the broader motor yachts class, constructed on a fiberglass hull.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The overall length ( **LOA** ) measures 95 ft (29.2 m), the overall width ( **Beam** ) is 22 ft (6.94 m), and the **Draft** comes in at 6.89 ft (2.1 m).

Q: How fast is it and what powers it? A: Typical **cruising speed** is 10 kn (11.51 mph) with a **maximum speed** of 24 kn (27.62 mph), achieved using a single **1 x MTU inboard diesel** engine.

Q: How many people can stay aboard? A: The yacht provides **accommodation** for 12 guests with **6 heads** , and includes a dedicated **crew** section offering 3 cabins and 5 berths.

Q: Who designed it and what materials are used? A: The **Hull designer** is Nuvolari Lenard Sri and the **Interior designer** is Nuvolari Lenard. ## Owner Experience Review

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Owners tend to choose the MCY96 from Monte Carlo Yachts for family-focused cruising and for operations with modest crew sizes (commonly 3–4); as one

owner noted, “we don’t need too many crew.” The main-deck owner stateroom with panoramic views and a roomy saloon that links directly to the cockpit give the boat an expansive, big-boat feeling within its class, while the adaptable lower deck can be configured for four guest cabins or reworked into larger VIP/owner arrangements. The standard layout places the galley-down, although galley-up is available as an option, and multiple owners praise the sporty exterior styling and the quality of interior finishes: “We fell in love with its sporty look and design.”

Underway, the MCY96 typically performs most comfortably between 16–22 knots, with sea trials indicating a peak speed near 24.5 knots. Its handling is described as responsive, showing a modest lean through turns; on one demonstration, a temporary prop ventilation issue was later attributed to a damaged prop blade. This temperament makes it well suited to relaxed coastal passages and social cruising where onboard comfort takes precedence over high-speed runs.

Routine upkeep commonly includes annual MTU servicing for the main engines and generators. Recorded refit activity shows replacements such as engine, service and emergency battery banks; a starboard oil heat exchanger and injection pump; a turbocharger for the starboard generator; various seawater-cooling circuit pipes; ASEA converter control-board modules; as well as work on pumps, watermaker maintenance and antifouling. Control-system maintenance has included CMC fin stabiliser servo control-box and potentiometer swaps accompanied by software updates. Engineers report practical engine-room access, noting “good space between the engines” with entry available through deck hatches or via the transom.

## Pros and Cons

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- A main-deck owner cabin with expansive views and a saloon that opens to

the cockpit creates a sense of big-boat volume uncommon in this size category.

- Generous flybridge and ample al-fresco spaces make the yacht well suited for charter operations and entertaining guests.
- The adaptable lower-deck plan and the option between galley-up and galley-down layouts allow owners to tailor the yacht for private use or charter service.
- The yacht is most economical and comfortable at a 16–22-knot cruise range rather than designed for sustained high-speed operation.
- The standard galley-down configuration may disappoint buyers who have a strong preference for a galley-up layout.
- Maintenance records indicate periodic replacement of batteries, cooling and fuel system components, control electronics, and stabiliser equipment.

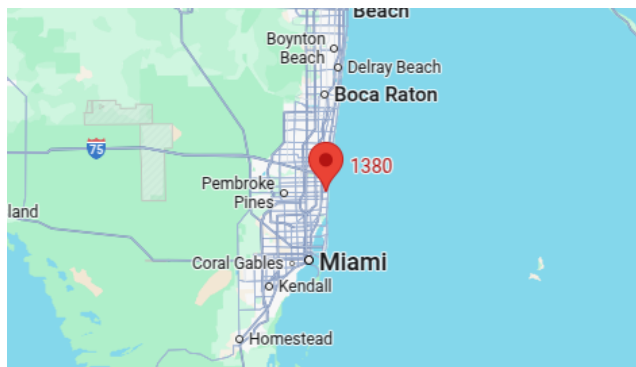
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
