Owner Experience Review

From current broker materials and yard information, the Moon 70 POWER by MOON YACHTS is presented as a wide-beam power catamaran tailored for private family blue-water passages and crewed charter operations. The design concept highlights stability and long-range efficiency along with generous entertaining areas—an expansive panoramic saloon, open-plan interiors, large exterior decks, and an elevated flybridge.

There are no published owner reports or forum discussions yet that describe real-world use of this model, nor are there independent sea-trial or handling reviews specific to the Moon 70 POWER. Some advertisements reference expected cruise and top speeds by comparing to the Moon 60 (commonly quoted around 8–12 knots cruising and approximately 20 knots top), but those figures have not been verified for the 70 and should be treated as indicative rather than confirmed.

Market entries list the model as a 2027 new build, so long-term ownership feedback, maintenance anecdotes, and routine operating-cost details are not yet available. Spec sheets for the Moon 60 Power reference mainstream inboard diesel suppliers (for example MAN or Volvo), suggesting conventional twin-diesel servicing patterns; nonetheless, specific owner commentary about

engine-room access, recurring maintenance items, or lifecycle costs for the Moon 70 POWER has not yet emerged.

Pros and Cons

- Wide-beam power catamaran layout designed to prioritize both stability and efficient long-range passage-making.
- Promoted as suitable for private family blue-water cruising and also for crewed charter operations with generous entertainment areas.
- Highly configurable accommodations and social spaces, with a panoramic saloon, flybridge, and multiple guest and crew layout possibilities described in broker and yard materials.
- No owner sea-trial or independent handling reports exist for the Moon 70 POWER to substantiate performance assertions.
- Ride comfort and seakeeping characteristics remain undocumented, and suggested speed figures are only loosely inferred from the Moon 60 model.
- Absence of owner-reported maintenance histories, access notes, or operating-cost data due to the model's new-build (2027) status.
