Owner Experience Review

Owners who take delivery of the 48 Pleasure from MTI commonly place it in high speed “fun run” duty and poker run circuits, with frequent references to events like the Lake of the Ozarks Shootout, manufacturer demo days, and rapid island hops such as Haulover to Key West or Bimini. Reviews from proprietors and industry experts highlight very high straight line speed when the boat is outfitted with Mercury Racing setups—some configurations report triple digit mph numbers—along with quick, decisive turns and a tendency to maintain acceleration in choppy seas. Experienced owners emphasize that any craft capable of speeds above 40–50 mph should be handled only after professional training.

Aboard, the design emphasizes socializing: a roomy open cockpit configured in arrangements like “G6 8” (four forward seats and four aft) and a party level stereo system are regular owner highlights. When rafted together, owners describe opening hatches and doors and feeling like there are “20 huge speakers,” while helm and deck ergonomics are praised for space and functionality, often featuring Seadek decking, Garmin and VesselView instrumentation, and upgraded stereo/intercom packages.

The trade offs are maintenance and operating cost. One owner called it the “boat of a lifetime” yet found the ongoing upkeep overwhelming, noting that work and expenses continue even when the engines are idle. Reported fuel consumption near wide open throttle runs about 48–52 gph per engine—approximately \$384 per hour at \$4/gal—while replacement parts can be costly (owners reference engines around \$130k and CNC Mercury props in the low to mid five figures), plus frequent detailing after high speed outings. For those who accept these commitments, the reward is the exceptional performance and lively social environment this platform is designed to create.

Pros and Cons

- Triple digit mph capability in some builds when equipped with Mercury Racing packages.
- Confident high speed behavior with fast, smart turns and acceleration even in rough conditions.
- Large open cockpit and a powerful stereo make raft ups and entertaining easy.
- Requires professional instruction to operate safely at the speeds it can reach.
- Demands frequent maintenance, cleanup, and detailing, as owners report.
- High operating costs, including near WOT fuel burn of 48–52 gph per engine and expensive components.
